

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #8 - ending 26 June 2011

Summary: Influenza-like activity is low


This survey was sent on Monday 27 June 1:13 AM and by Thursday 30 June 9:00 AM we had received 10511 responses (10553 last week) from 7200 people responding for themselves and 3311 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 3.2% of vaccinated participants and 3.6% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.6% of vaccinated participants and 1.6% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 6911/10510 (65.8%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2447 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1966 (80.3%) have received the vaccine.
