

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #9 - ending 3 July 2011

Summary: Influenza-like activity is low


This survey was sent on Monday 4 July 12:45 AM and by Thursday 7 July 9:00 AM we had received 10273 responses (10523 last week) from 7083 people responding for themselves and 3190 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 3.4% of vaccinated participants and 3.6% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.9% of vaccinated participants and 1.9% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 6749/10273 (65.7%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2398 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1916 (79.9%) have received the vaccine.
