

## Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

### Week #11 - ending 17 July 2011

#### Summary: Influenza-like activity is low


This survey was sent on Monday 18 July 1:08 AM and by Thursday 21 July 9:00 AM we had received 10180 responses (10223 last week) from 7060 people responding for themselves and 3120 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 3.1% of vaccinated participants and 3.1% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.8% of vaccinated participants and 1.5% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 6693/10180 (65.7%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2375 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1891 (79.6%) have received the vaccine.
