

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #12 - ending 24 July 2011

Summary: Influenza-like activity is low


This survey was sent on Monday 25 July 12:29 AM and by Thursday 28 July 9:00 AM we had received 10668 responses (10191 last week) from 7293 people responding for themselves and 3375 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.4% of vaccinated participants and 3.5% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.3% of vaccinated participants and 1.7% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 7013/10667 (65.7%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2461 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1970 (80.0%) have received the vaccine.
