

## Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

### Week #14 - ending 7 August 2011

#### Summary: Influenza-like activity is low


This survey was sent on Monday 8 August 12:25 AM and by Thursday 11 August 9:00 AM we had received 10579 responses (10530 last week) from 7237 people responding for themselves and 3342 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 3.0% of vaccinated participants and 3.7% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 2.0% of vaccinated participants and 2.1% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 6944/10579 (65.6%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2406 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1931 (80.3%) have received the vaccine.
