Summary: Influenza-like-illness activity is low


This survey was sent on Monday 15 August 12:54 AM and by Thursday 18 August 9:00 AM we had received 10448 responses (10566 last week) from 7192 people responding for themselves and 3256 household members across Australia.

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 3.6% of vaccinated participants and 4.0% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 2.1% of vaccinated participants and 2.6% of unvaccinated participants.


For participants this week, 6890/10447 (66.0%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2412 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1935 (80.2%) have received the vaccine.
