

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #18 - ending 4 September 2011

Summary: Influenza-like-illness activity is low.


This survey was sent on Monday 5 September 6:40 AM and by Thursday 8 September 9:00 AM we had received 10186 responses (10287 last week) from 6979 people responding for themselves and 3207 household members across Australia.


Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.9% of vaccinated participants and 3.3% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.6% of vaccinated participants and 1.6% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 5680/10186 (55.8%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2324 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1699 (73.1%) have received the vaccine.
