

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #20 - ending 18 September 2011

Summary: Influenza-like-illness activity is low.

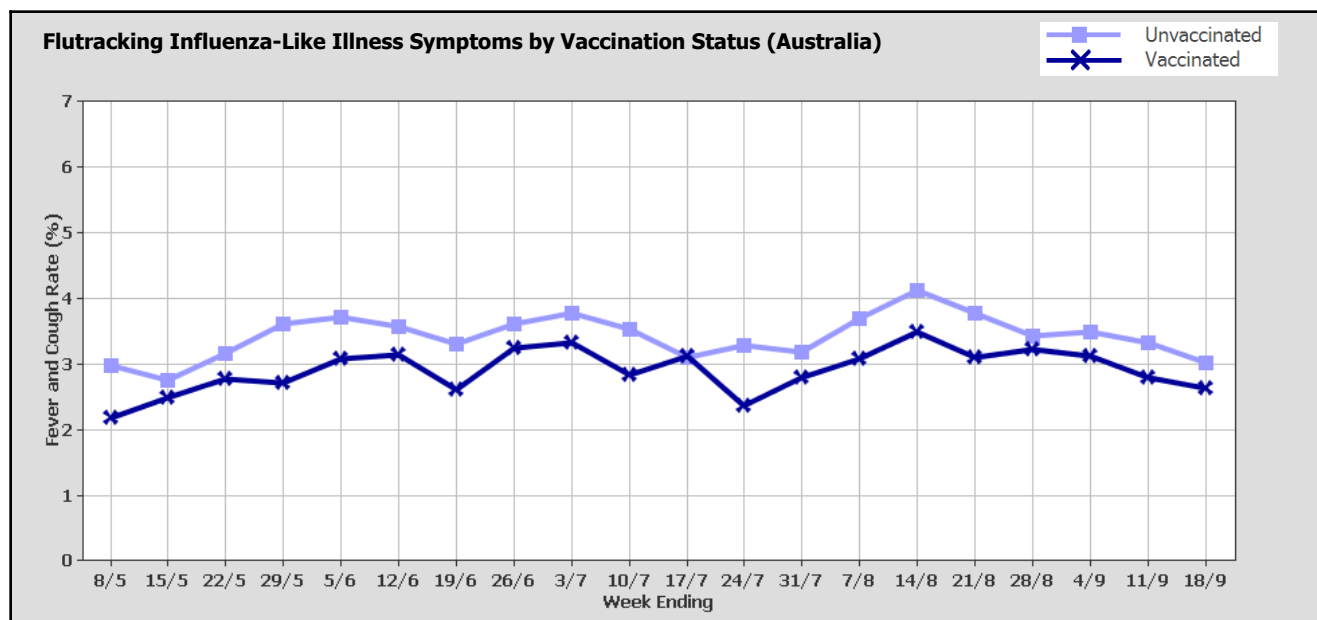
This survey was sent on Monday 19 September 6:51 AM and by Thursday 22 September 9:00 AM we had received 10069 responses (10150 last week) from 6875 people responding for themselves and 3194 household members across Australia.

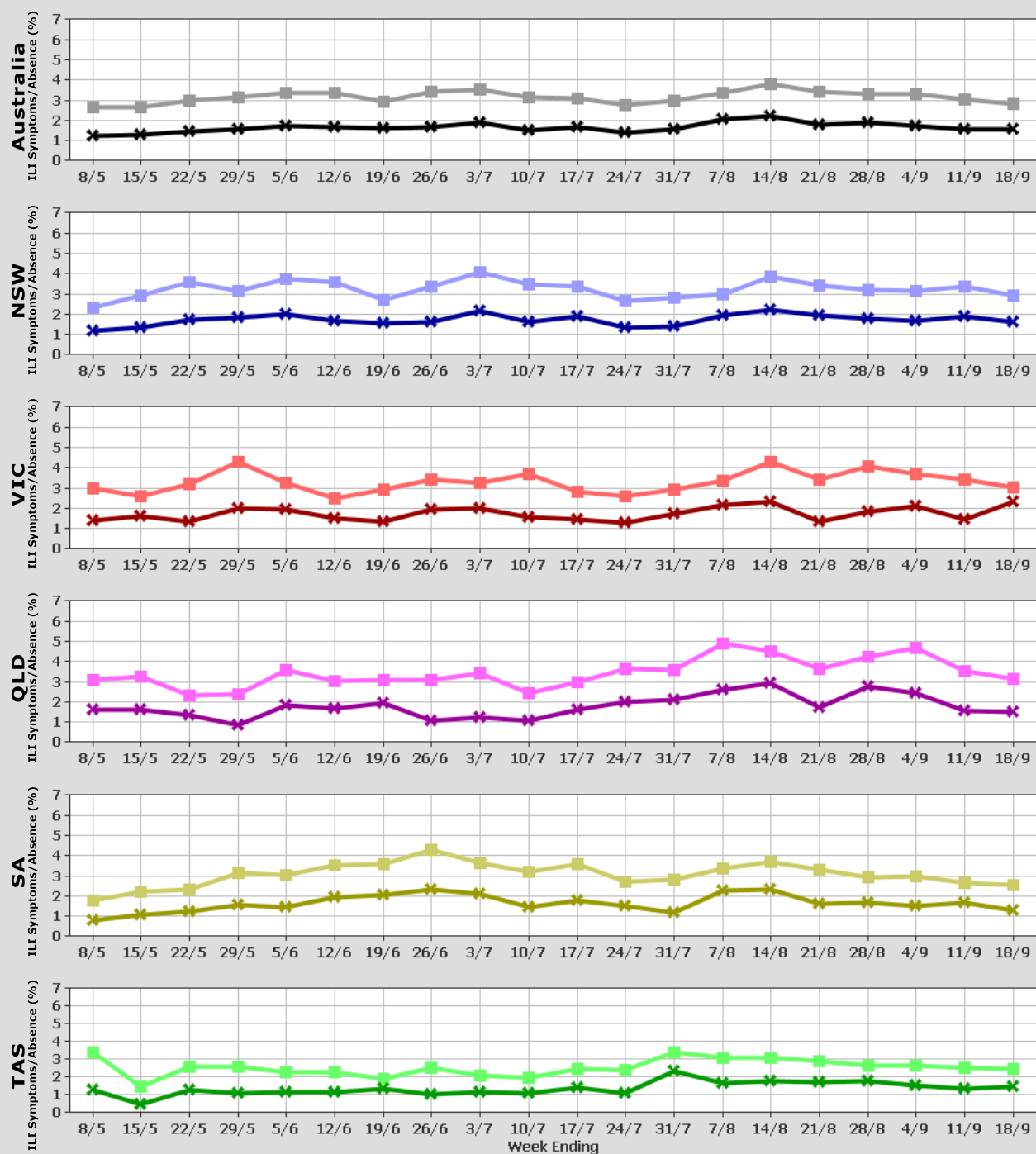
Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.6% of vaccinated participants and 3.0% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.6% of vaccinated participants and 1.6% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 5619/10069 (55.8%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2320 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1702 (73.4%) have received the vaccine.
