

## Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

### Week #21 - ending 25 September 2011

**Summary: Influenza-like-illness activity is low.**


This survey was sent on Monday 26 September 3:03 AM and by Thursday 29 September 9:00 AM we had received 9752 responses (10136 last week) from 6710 people responding for themselves and 3042 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.7% of vaccinated participants and 2.6% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.5% of vaccinated participants and 1.4% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 5487/9752 (56.3%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2279 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1675 (73.5%) have received the vaccine.
