

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #22 - ending 2 October 2011

Summary: Influenza-like-illness activity is low.

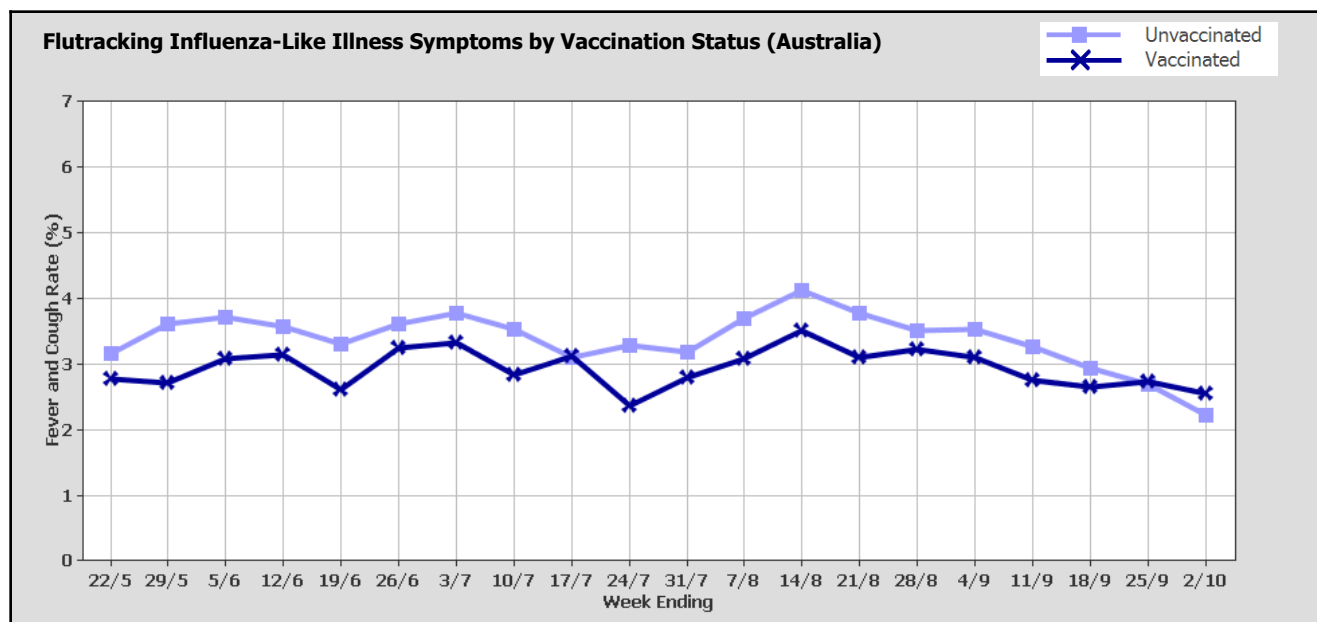
This survey was sent on Monday 3 October 6:08 AM and by Thursday 6 October 9:00 AM we had received 9250 responses (9723 last week) from 6437 people responding for themselves and 2813 household members across Australia.

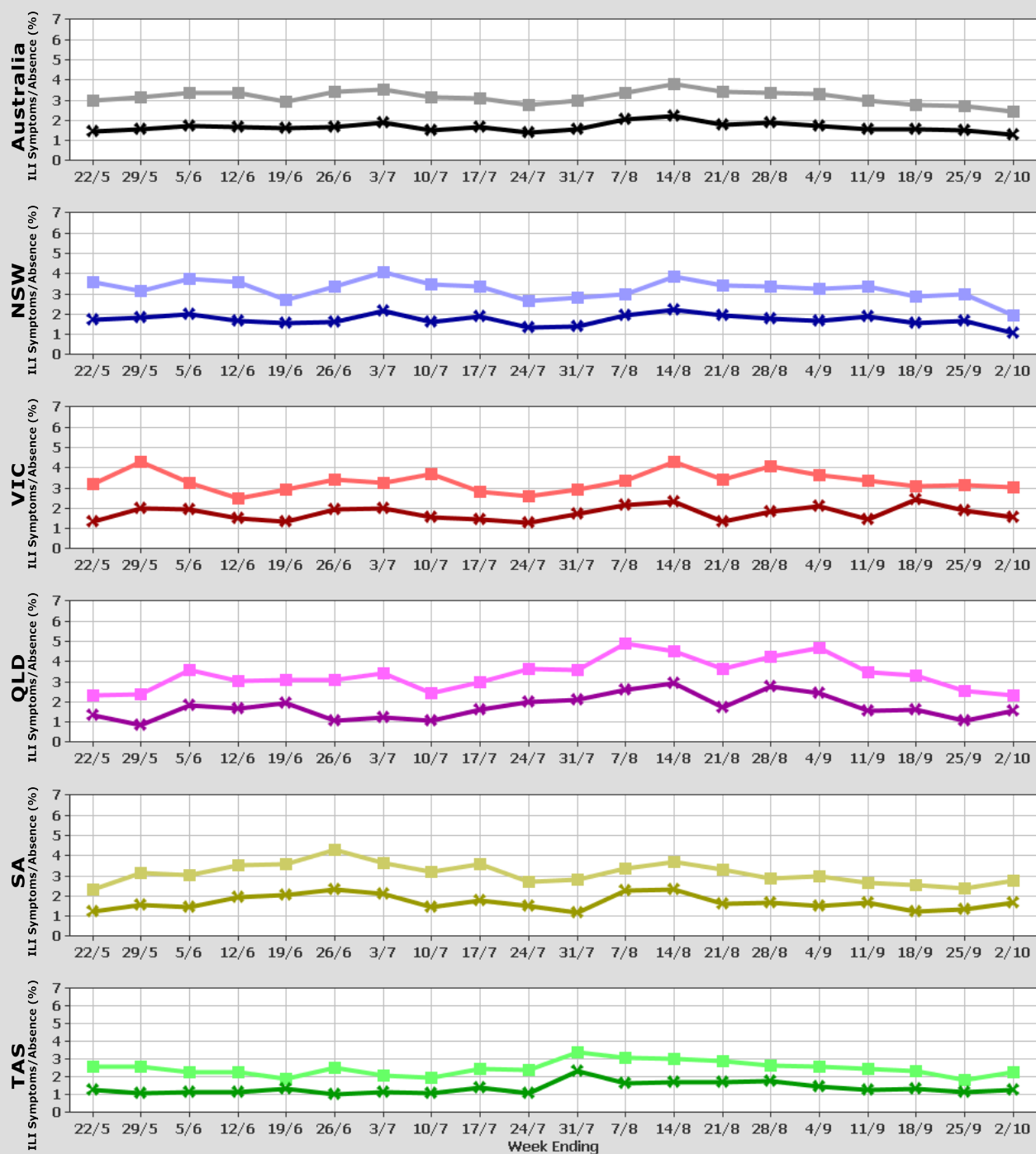
Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.6% of vaccinated participants and 2.2% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.3% of vaccinated participants and 1.3% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 5250/9250 (56.8%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2146 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1578 (73.5%) have received the vaccine.
