

## Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

### Week #24 - ending 16 October 2011

**Summary: Influenza-like-illness activity is low.**


This survey was sent on Monday 17 October 6:44 AM and by Thursday 20 October 9:00 AM we had received 10151 responses (9938 last week) from 6947 people responding for themselves and 3204 household members across Australia.


Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.3% of vaccinated participants and 2.4% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.1% of vaccinated participants and 1.3% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 5654/10151 (55.7%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2320 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1692 (72.9%) have received the vaccine.
