Low level influenza-like illness activity detected

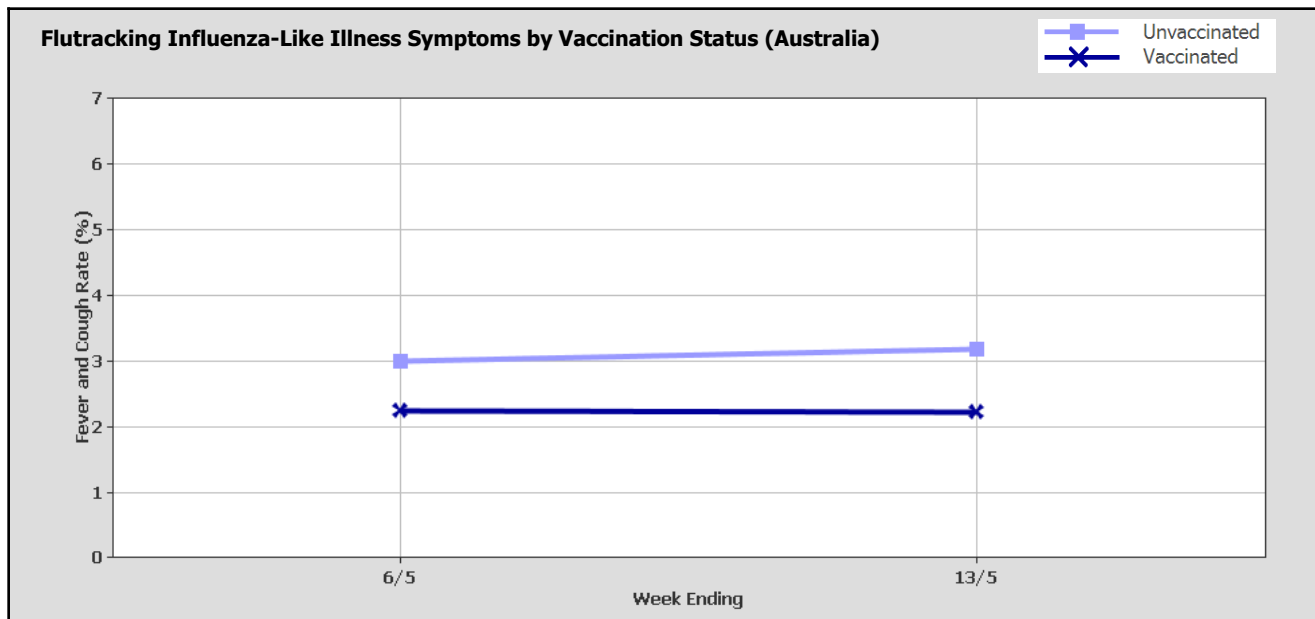
This survey was sent on Monday 14 May 12:04 PM and by Thursday 17 May 9:00 AM we had received 11814 responses (11319 last week) from 7681 people responding for themselves and 4133 household members across Australia.

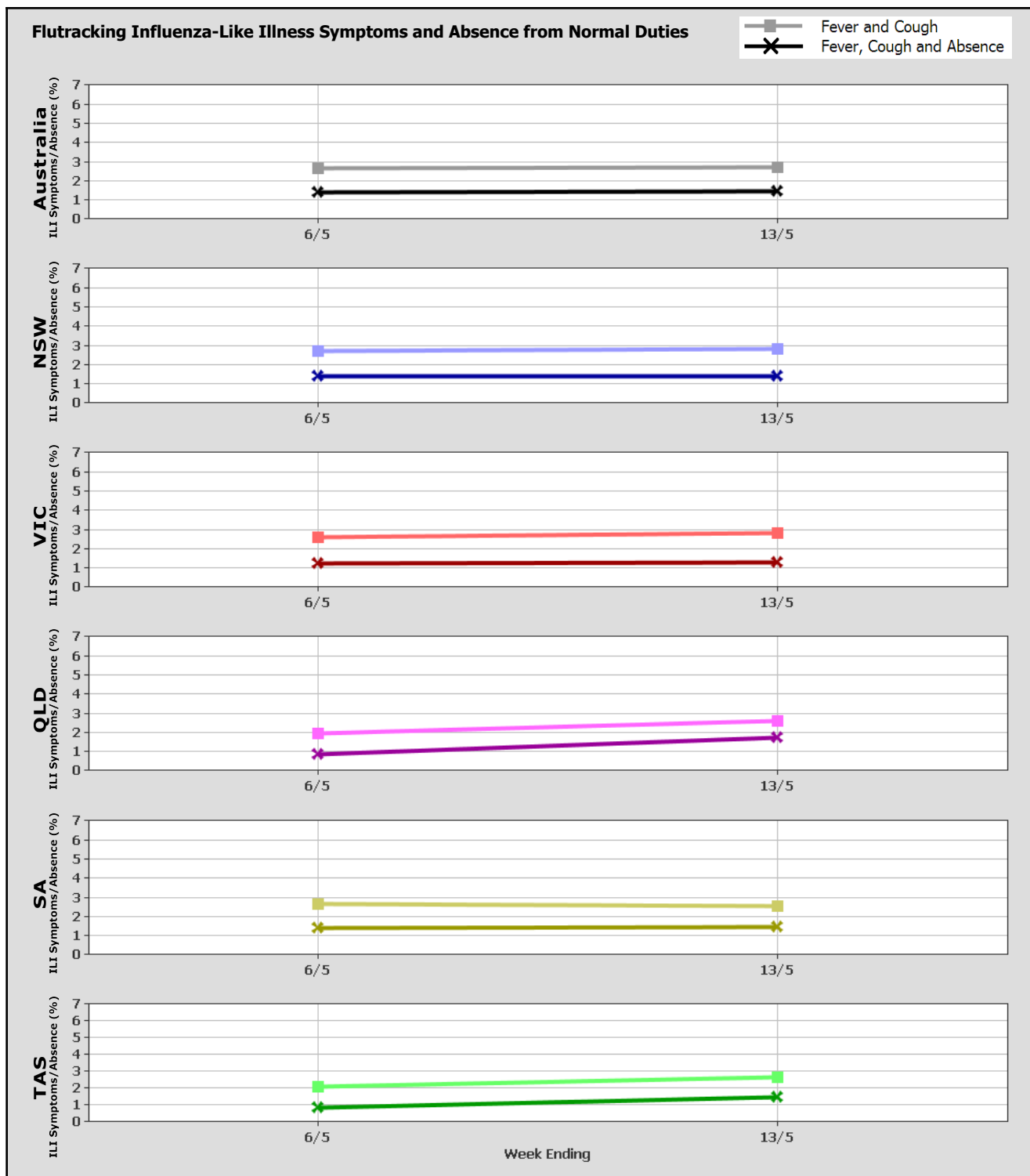

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.2% of vaccinated participants and 3.2% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.2% of vaccinated participants and 1.7% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 5497/11814 (46.5%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2394 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1595 (66.6%) have received the vaccine.
