Low level influenza-like illness activity detected


This survey was sent on Monday 21 May 8:29 AM and by Thursday 24 May 9:00 AM we had received 10757 responses (11890 last week) from 6950 people responding for themselves and 3807 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.8% of vaccinated participants and 3.1% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.5% of vaccinated participants and 1.8% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 5144/10757 (47.8%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 1995 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1348 (67.6%) have received the vaccine.
