Low level influenza-like illness activity detected

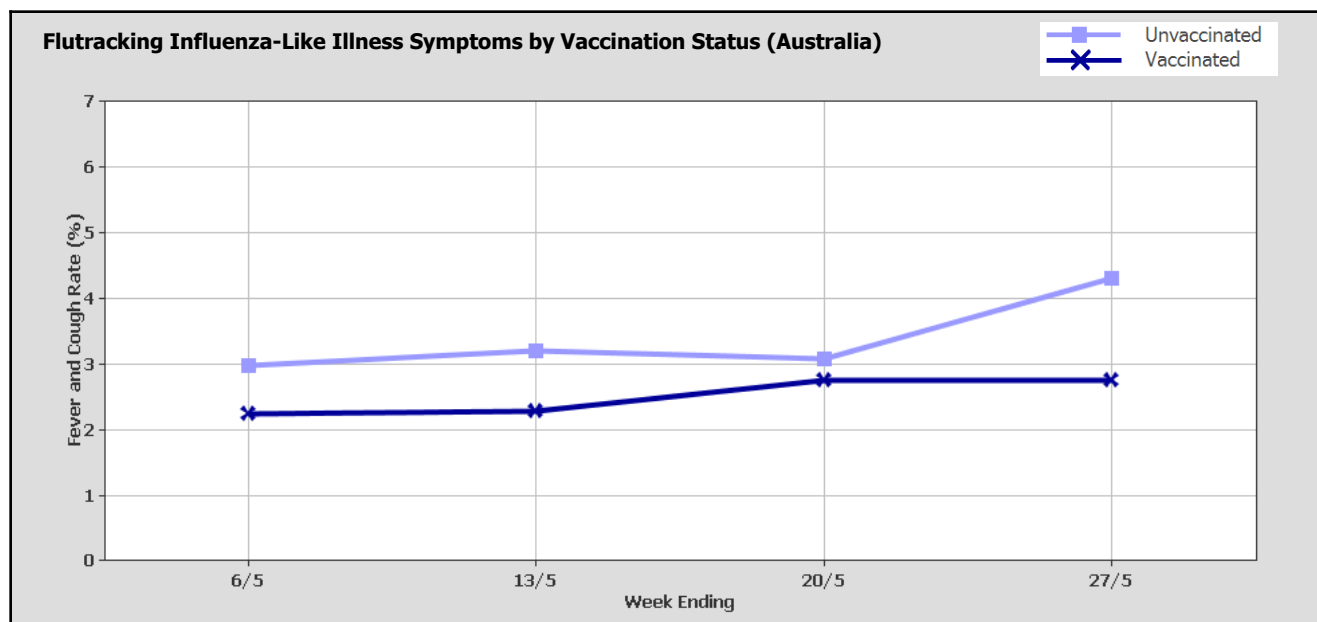
This survey was sent on Monday 28 May 8:13 AM and by Thursday 31 May 9:00 AM we had received 12286 responses (12052 last week) from 8037 people responding for themselves and 4249 household members across Australia.

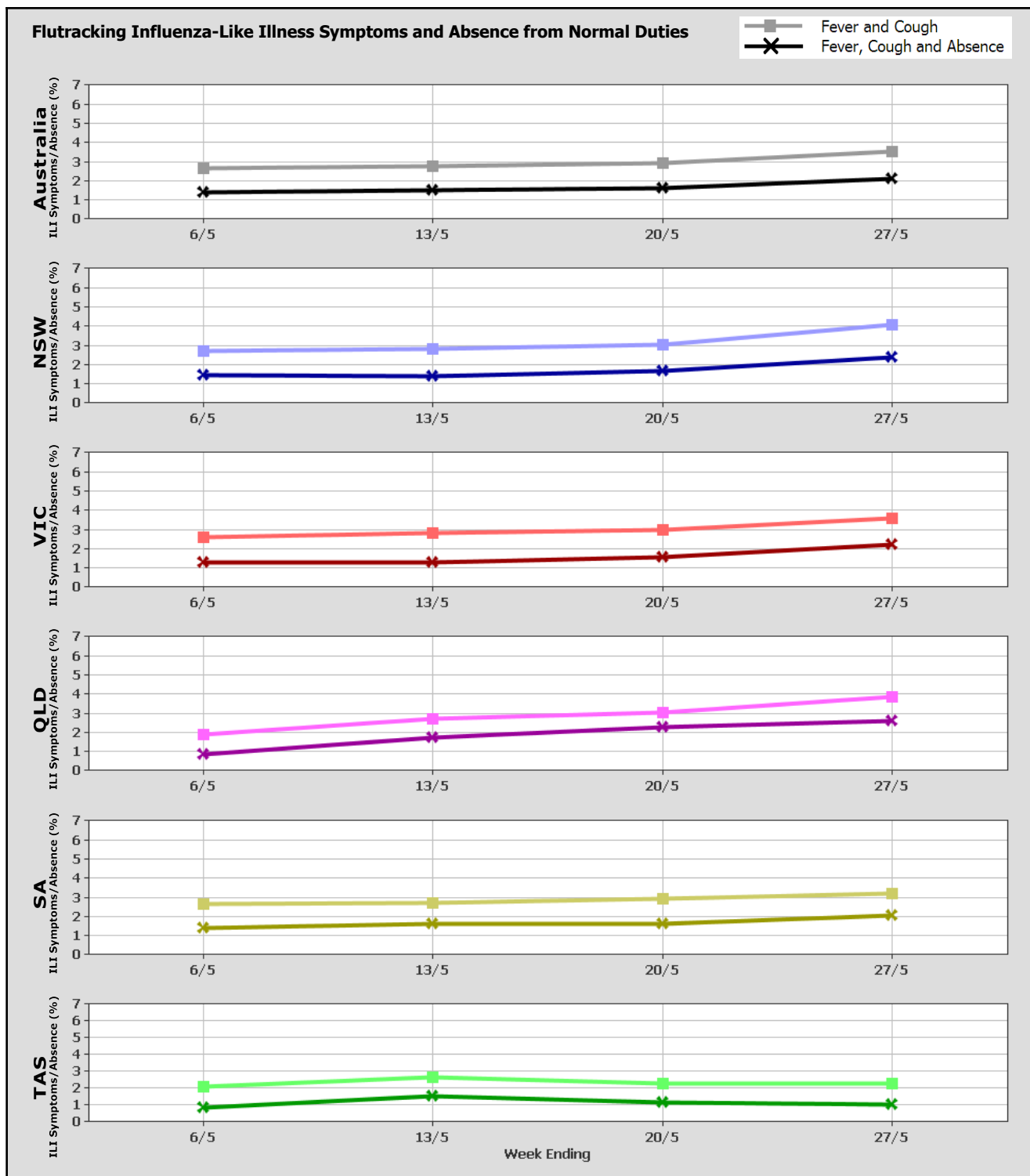

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.8% of vaccinated participants and 4.3% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.5% of vaccinated participants and 2.7% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 6090/12286 (49.6%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2492 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1722 (69.1%) have received the vaccine.
