

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #5 - ending 3 June 2012

Low level influenza-like illness activity detected

This survey was sent on Monday 4 June 7:43 AM and by Thursday 7 June 9:00 AM we had received 12379 responses (12296 last week) from 8118 people responding for themselves and 4261 household members across Australia.

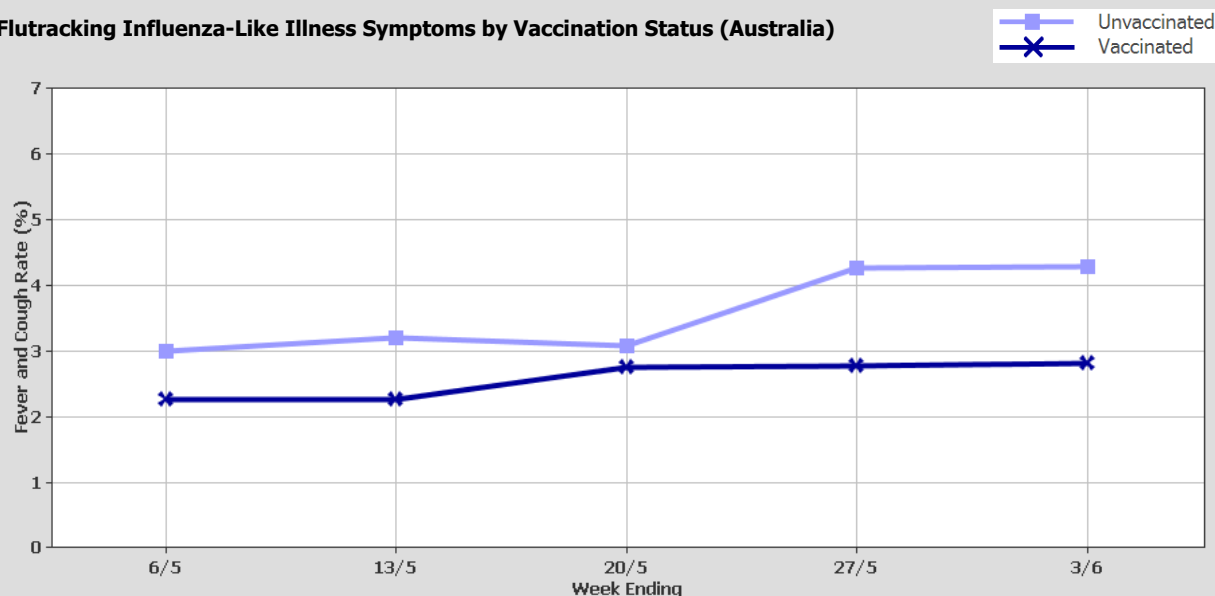

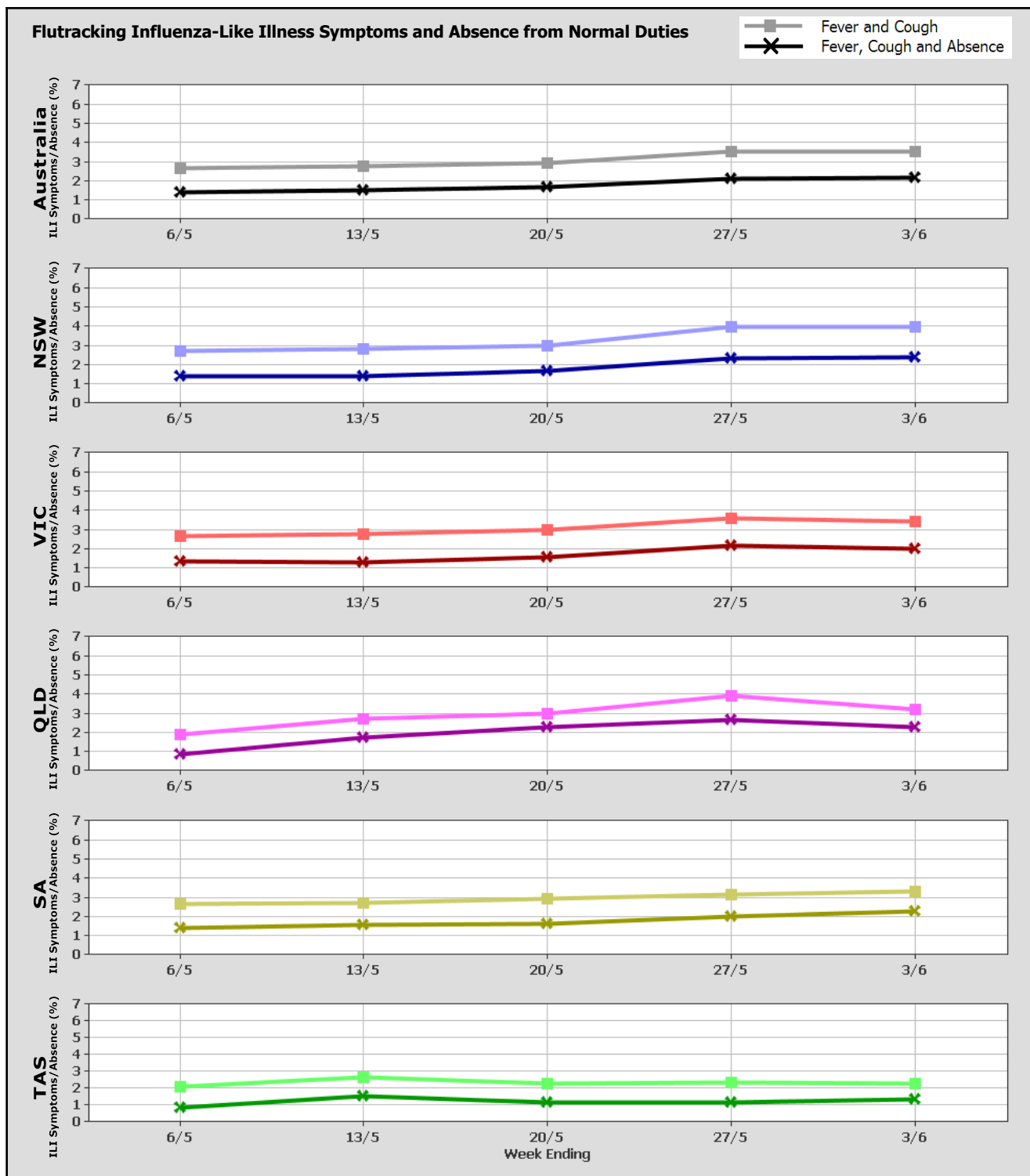

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.8% of vaccinated participants and 4.3% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.7% of vaccinated participants and 2.6% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 6257/12379 (50.5%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2554 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1775 (69.5%) have received the vaccine.
