Low level influenza-like illness activity detected


This survey was sent on Monday 11 June 1:13 AM and by Thursday 14 June 9:00 AM we had received 12205 responses (12521 last week) from 7985 people responding for themselves and 4220 household members across Australia.

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.9% of vaccinated participants and 3.1% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.7% of vaccinated participants and 1.7% of unvaccinated participants.


For participants this week, 6285/12205 (51.5%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2514 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1777 (70.7%) have received the vaccine.
