Moderate influenza-like illness activity detected


This survey was sent on Monday 16 July 12:43 AM and by Thursday 19 July 9:00 AM we had received 12795 responses (12246 last week) from 8364 people responding for themselves and 4431 household members across Australia.

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 4.4% of vaccinated participants and 4.8% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 2.6% of vaccinated participants and 3.1% of unvaccinated participants.


For participants this week, 6842/12795 (53.5%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2680 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1954 (72.9%) have received the vaccine.
