

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #15 - ending 12 August 2012

Moderate levels of influenza-like illness activity detected but high activity persists in Queensland

This survey was sent on Monday 13 August 12:23 AM and by Thursday 16 August 9:00 AM we had received 12863 responses (12959 last week) from 8387 people responding for themselves and 4476 household members across Australia.

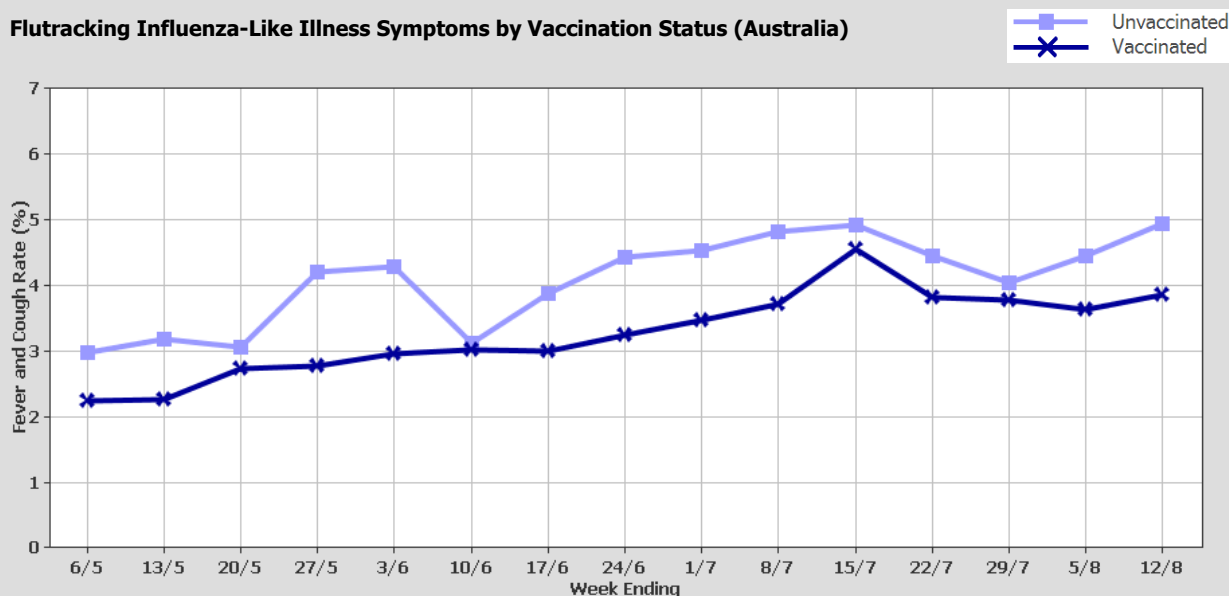

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 3.9% of vaccinated participants and 4.9% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 2.5% of vaccinated participants and 3.2% of unvaccinated participants.

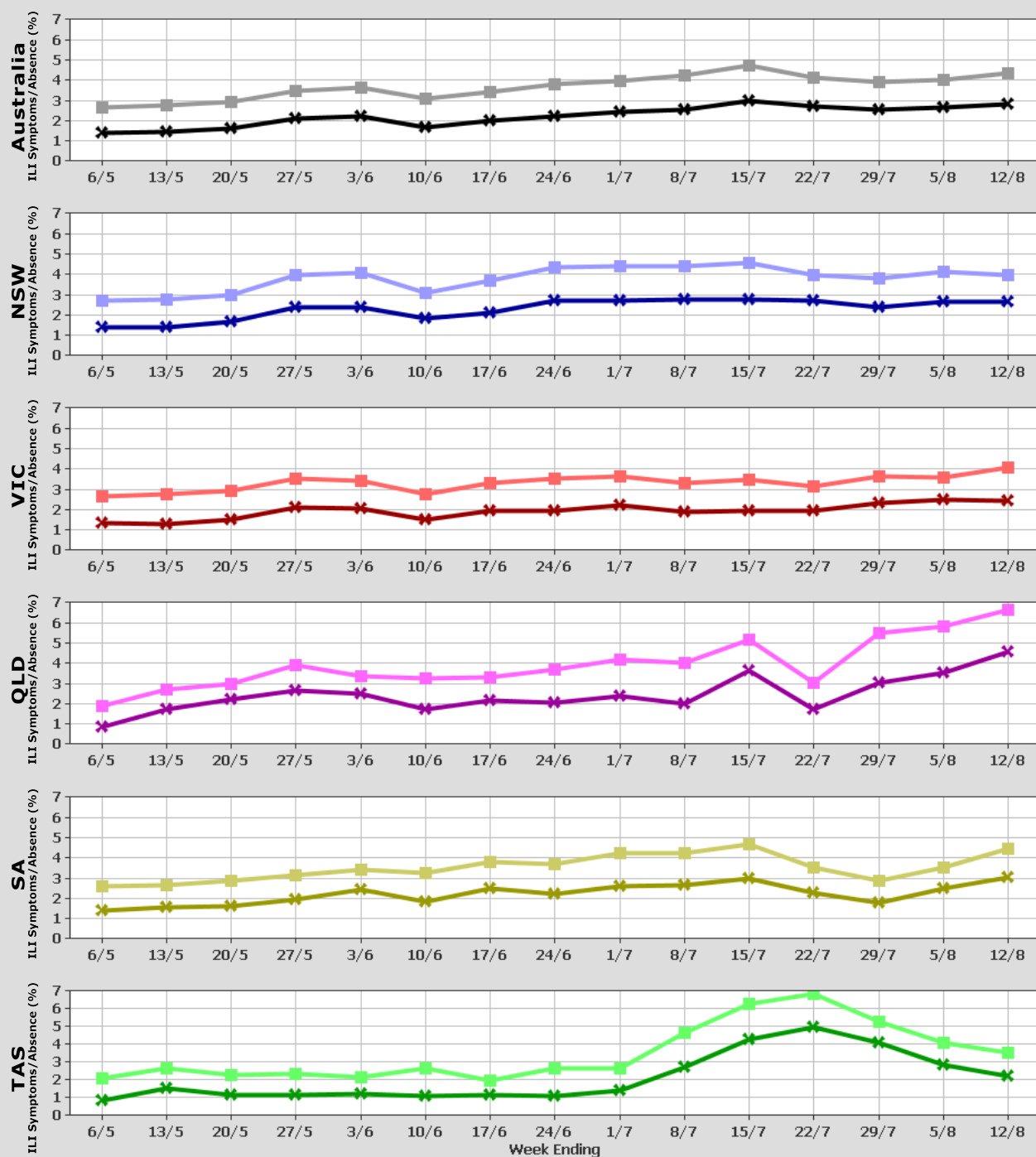
For participants this week, 6950/12862 (54.0%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2641 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1941 (73.5%) have received the vaccine.
