Moderate levels of influenza-like illness activity detected


This survey was sent on Monday 20 August 12:03 AM and by Thursday 23 August 9:00 AM we had received 12728 responses (12872 last week) from 8335 people responding for themselves and 4393 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 3.5% of vaccinated participants and 4.4% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 2.4% of vaccinated participants and 2.9% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 6914/12726 (54.3%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2599 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1931 (74.3%) have received the vaccine.
