Moderate but declining levels of influenza-like illness activity detected


This survey was sent on Monday 27 August 12:18 AM and by Thursday 30 August 9:00 AM we had received 12669 responses (12715 last week) from 8276 people responding for themselves and 4393 household members across Australia.

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 3.2% of vaccinated participants and 3.6% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.9% of vaccinated participants and 2.3% of unvaccinated participants.


For participants this week, 6900/12669 (54.5%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2586 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1905 (73.7%) have received the vaccine.
