

## Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

### Week #18 - ending 2 September 2012

#### Low levels of influenza-like illness detected


This survey was sent on Monday 3 September 12:09 AM and by Thursday 6 September 9:00 AM we had received 12701 responses (12673 last week) from 8265 people responding for themselves and 4436 household members across Australia.


#### Respondent Numbers by Jurisdiction

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 3.0% of vaccinated participants and 3.2% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.9% of vaccinated participants and 1.9% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 6905/12701 (54.4%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2622 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1931 (73.6%) have received the vaccine.
