Low levels of influenza-like illness detected

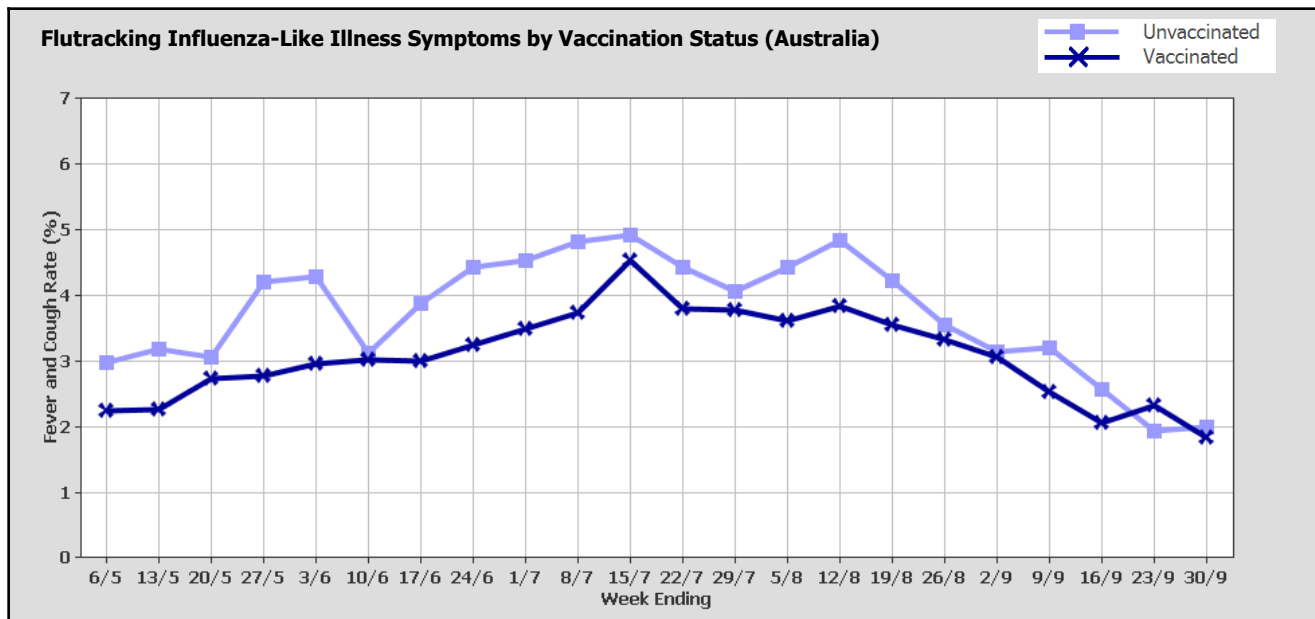
This survey was sent on Monday 1 October 12:08 AM and by Thursday 4 October 9:00 AM we had received 11475 responses (11793 last week) from 7547 people responding for themselves and 3928 household members across Australia.

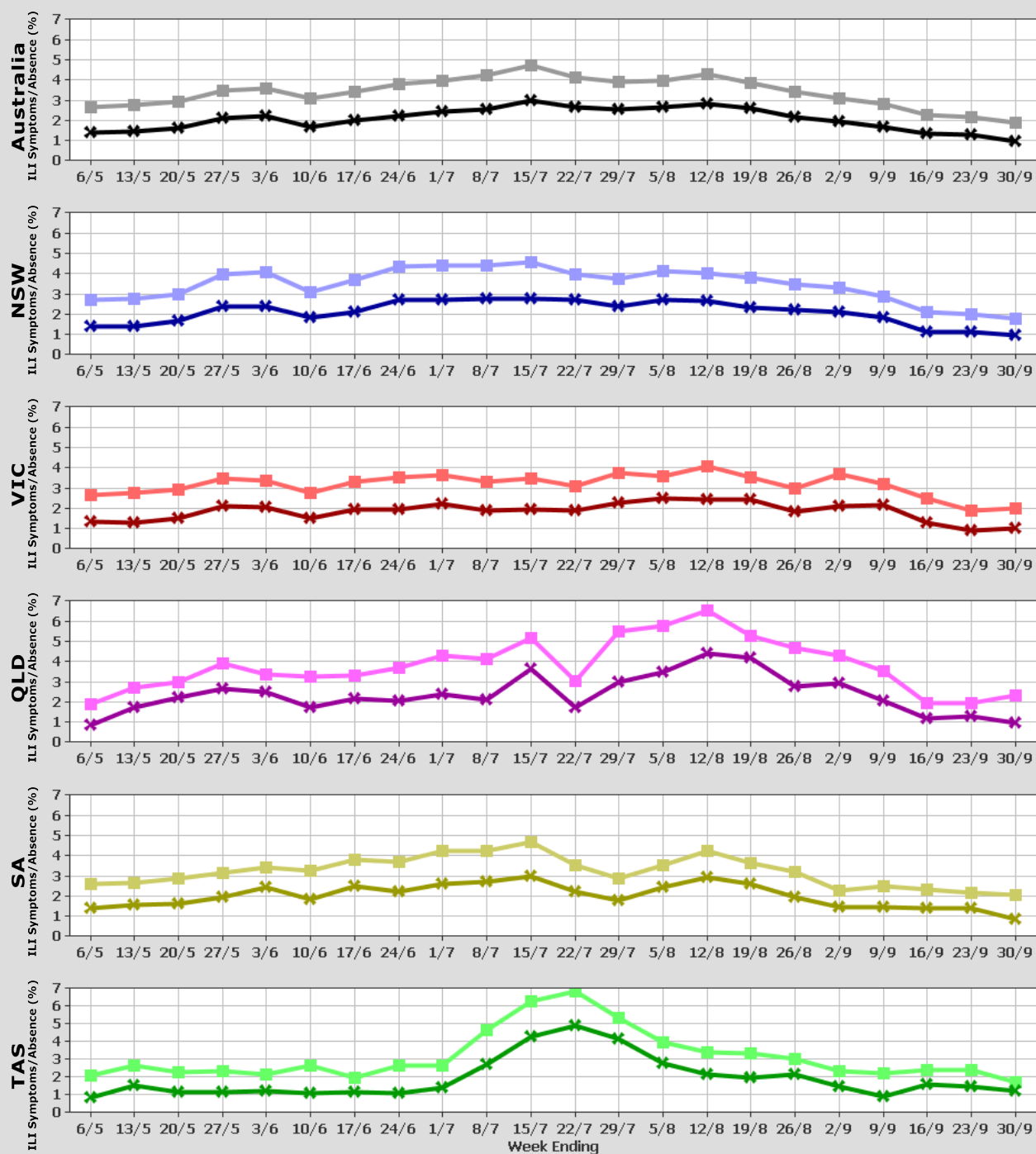
Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 1.8% of vaccinated participants and 2.0% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.1% of vaccinated participants and 0.9% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 6279/11475 (54.7%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2405 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1767 (73.5%) have received the vaccine.
