Low levels of influenza-like illness detected


This survey was sent on Monday 8 October 12:11 AM and by Thursday 11 October 9:00 AM we had received 11825 responses (11475 last week) from 7788 people responding for themselves and 4037 household members across Australia.

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 1.7% of vaccinated participants and 1.7% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.8% of vaccinated participants and 0.8% of unvaccinated participants.


For participants this week, 6477/11825 (54.8%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2455 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1815 (73.9%) have received the vaccine.
