

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #2 - ending 5 May 2013

Low level influenza-like illness activity. Graphs will be more informative as more weeks of data are included.

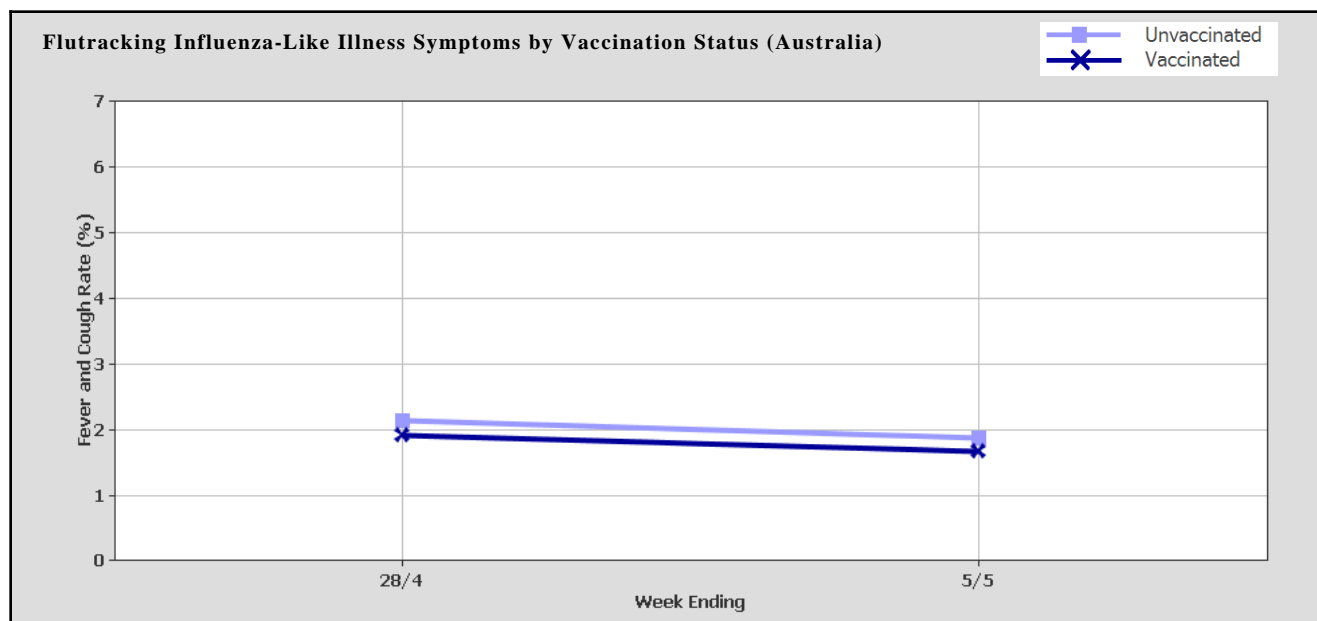
This survey was sent on Monday 6 May 7:17 AM and by Thursday 9 May 9:00 AM we had received 13837 responses (13239 last week) from 8804 people responding for themselves and 5033 household members across Australia.

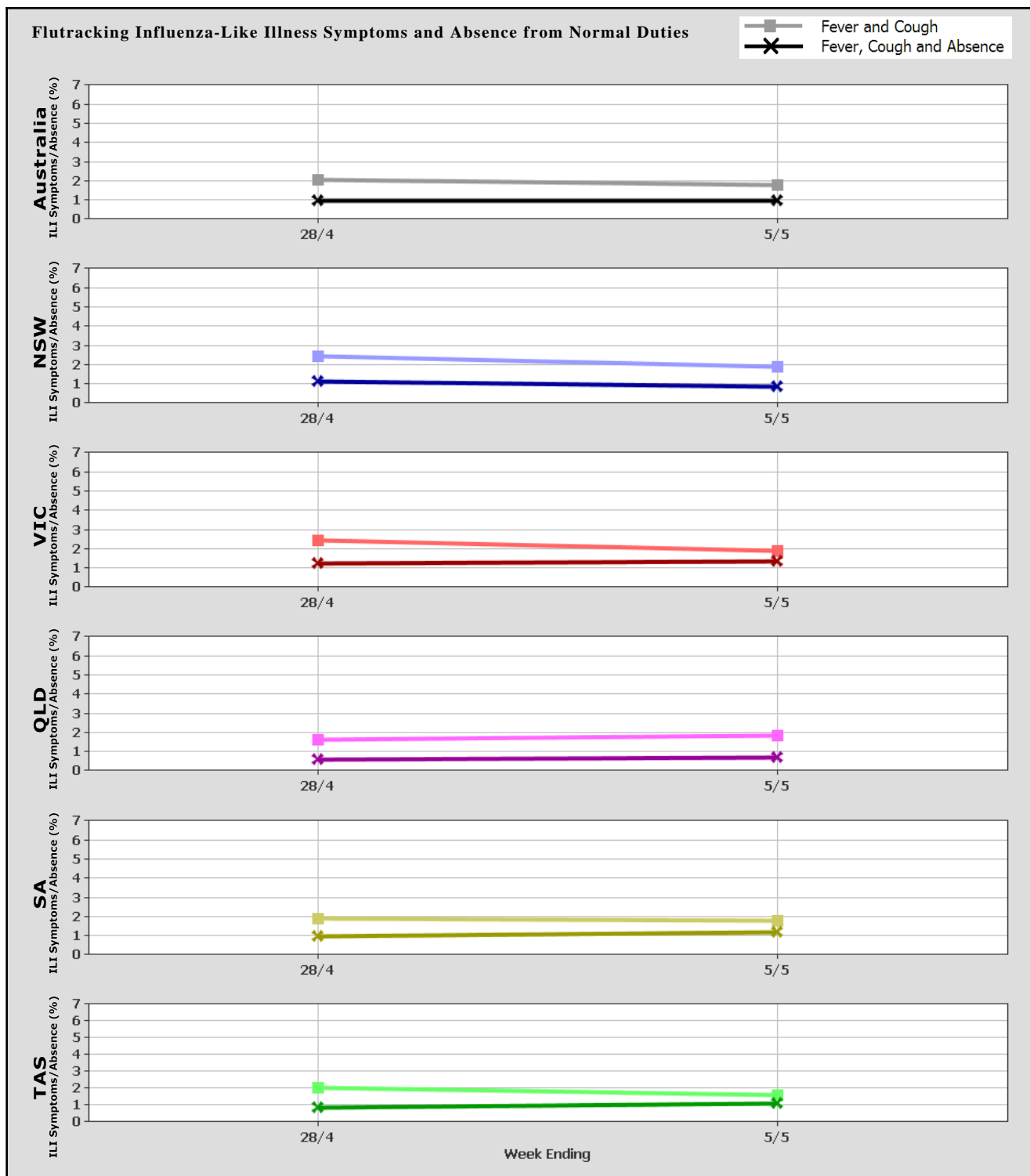

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 1.7% of vaccinated participants and 1.9% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.9% of vaccinated participants and 1.1% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 7293/13837 (52.7%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2756 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1976 (71.7%) have received the vaccine.
