

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #3 - ending 12 May 2013

Low level influenza-like illness activity. Graphs will be more informative as more weeks of data are included.


This survey was sent on Monday 13 May 12:21 AM and by Thursday 16 May 9:00 AM we had received 14102 responses (13947 last week) from 8952 people responding for themselves and 5150 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.0% of vaccinated participants and 2.1% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.1% of vaccinated participants and 1.0% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 7679/14098 (54.5%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2762 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2024 (73.3%) have received the vaccine.
