Low level influenza-like illness activity.


This survey was sent on Monday 27 May 12:22 AM and by Thursday 30 May 9:00 AM we had received 14816 responses (14760 last week) from 9481 people responding for themselves and 5335 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.2% of vaccinated participants and 2.7% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.2% of vaccinated participants and 1.8% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8445/14816 (57.0%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2922 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2220 (76.0%) have received the vaccine.
