Low level influenza-like illness activity.

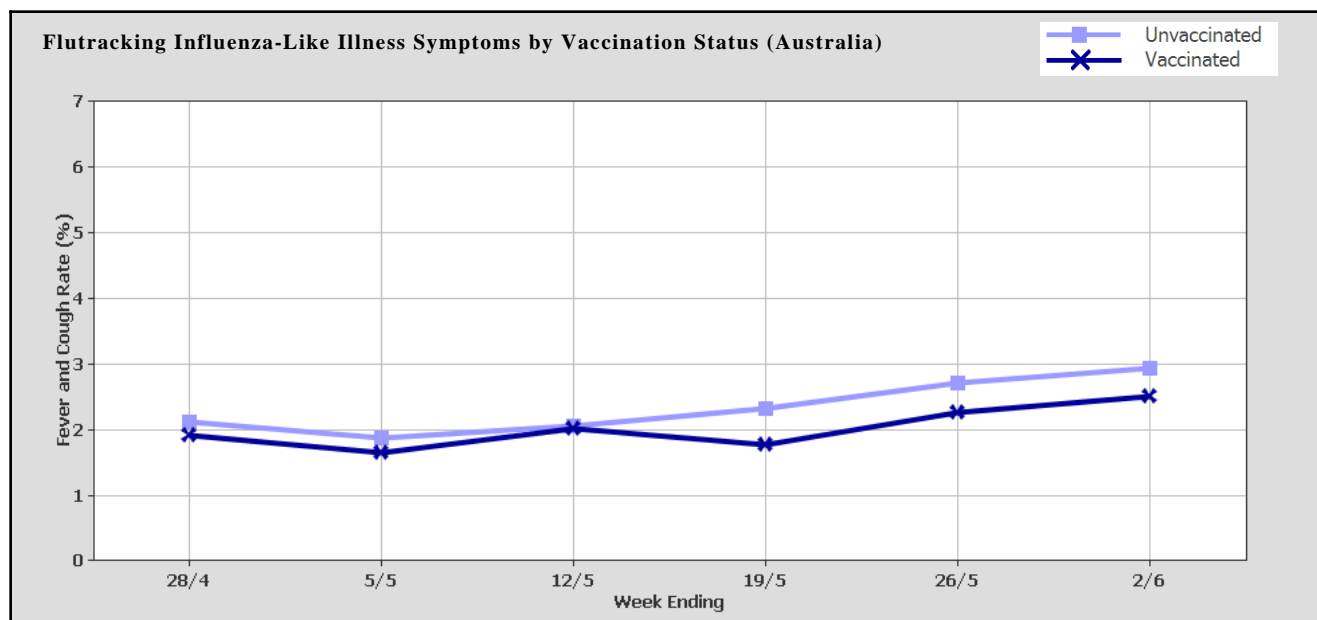
This survey was sent on Monday 3 June 12:14 AM and by Thursday 6 June 9:00 AM we had received 13958 responses (14819 last week) from 8957 people responding for themselves and 5001 household members across Australia.

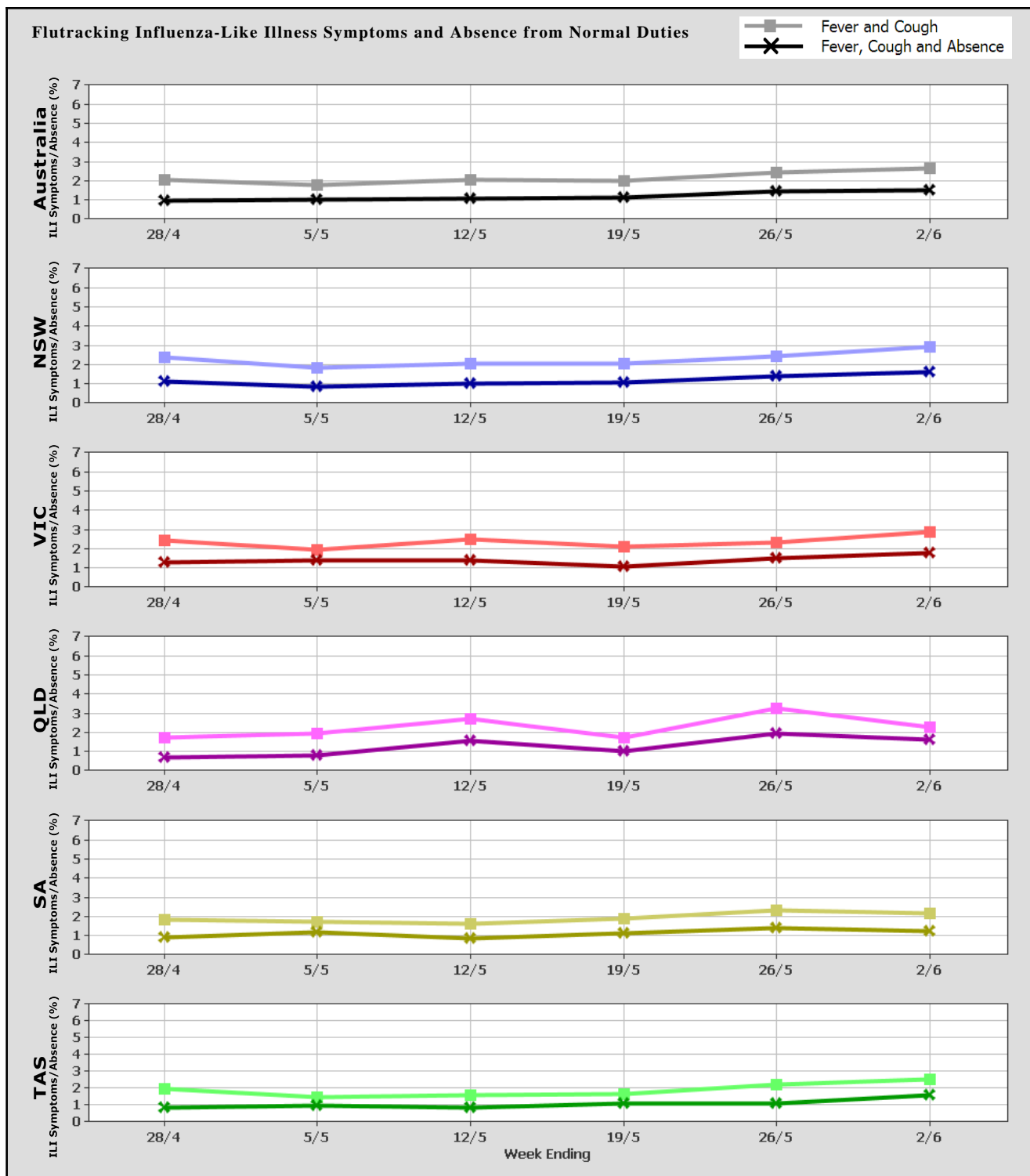

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.5% of vaccinated participants and 2.9% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.4% of vaccinated participants and 1.8% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8084/13958 (57.9%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2706 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2080 (76.9%) have received the vaccine.
