

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #7 - ending 9 June 2013

Low level influenza-like illness activity.

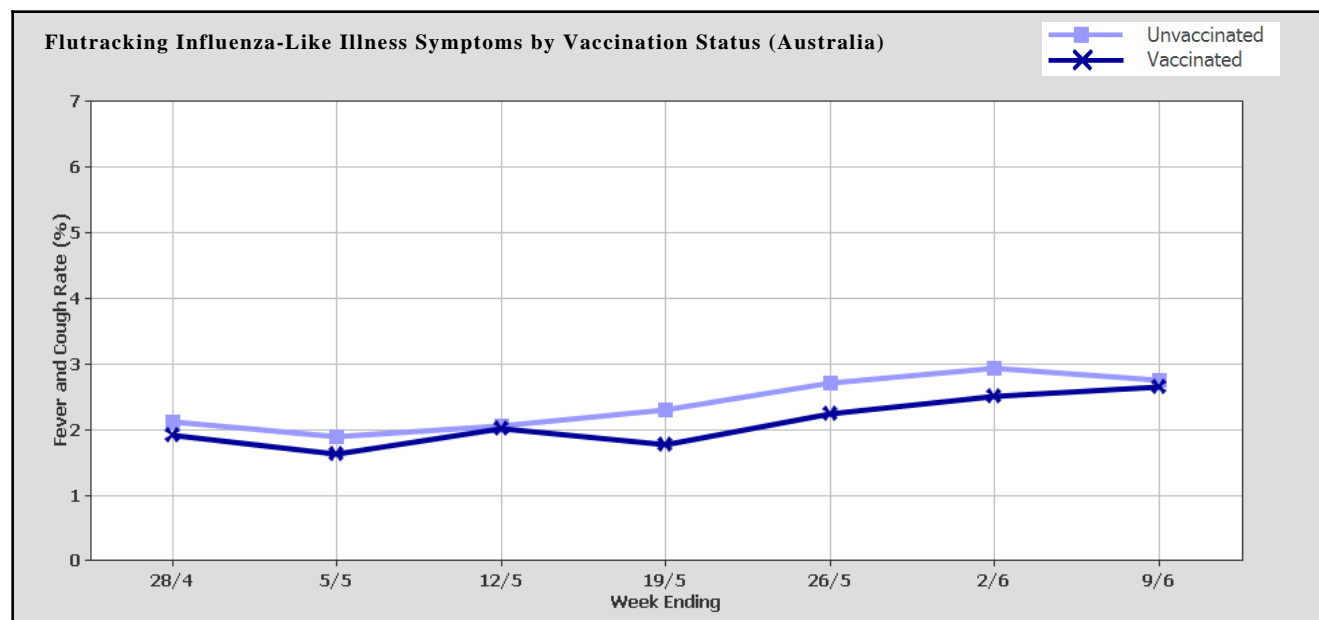
This survey was sent on Monday 10 June 3:18 AM and by Thursday 13 June 9:00 AM we had received 14502 responses (13911 last week) from 9325 people responding for themselves and 5177 household members across Australia.

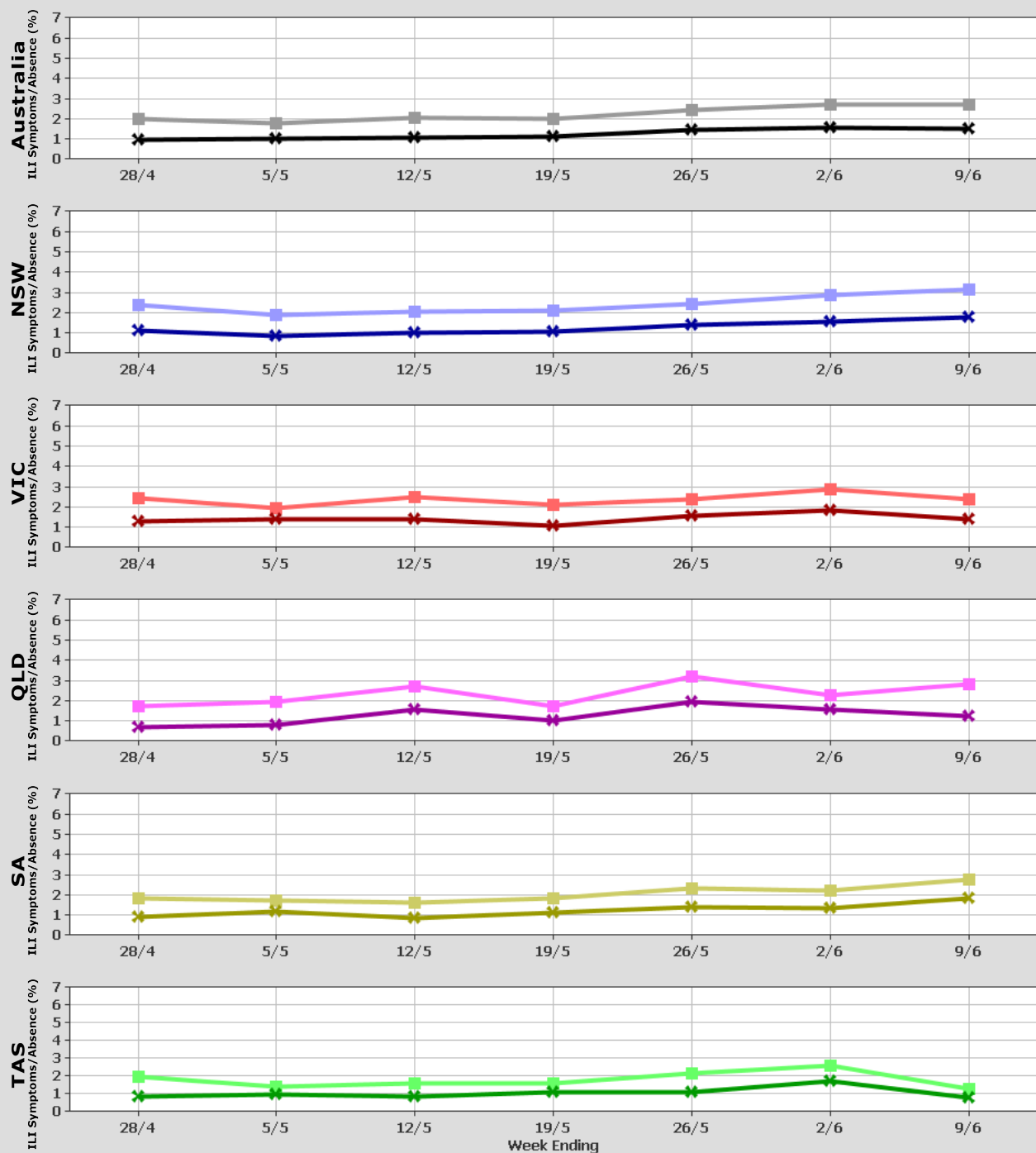
Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.7% of vaccinated participants and 2.8% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.5% of vaccinated participants and 1.5% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8405/14502 (58.0%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2856 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2195 (76.9%) have received the vaccine.
