Low level influenza-like illness activity.

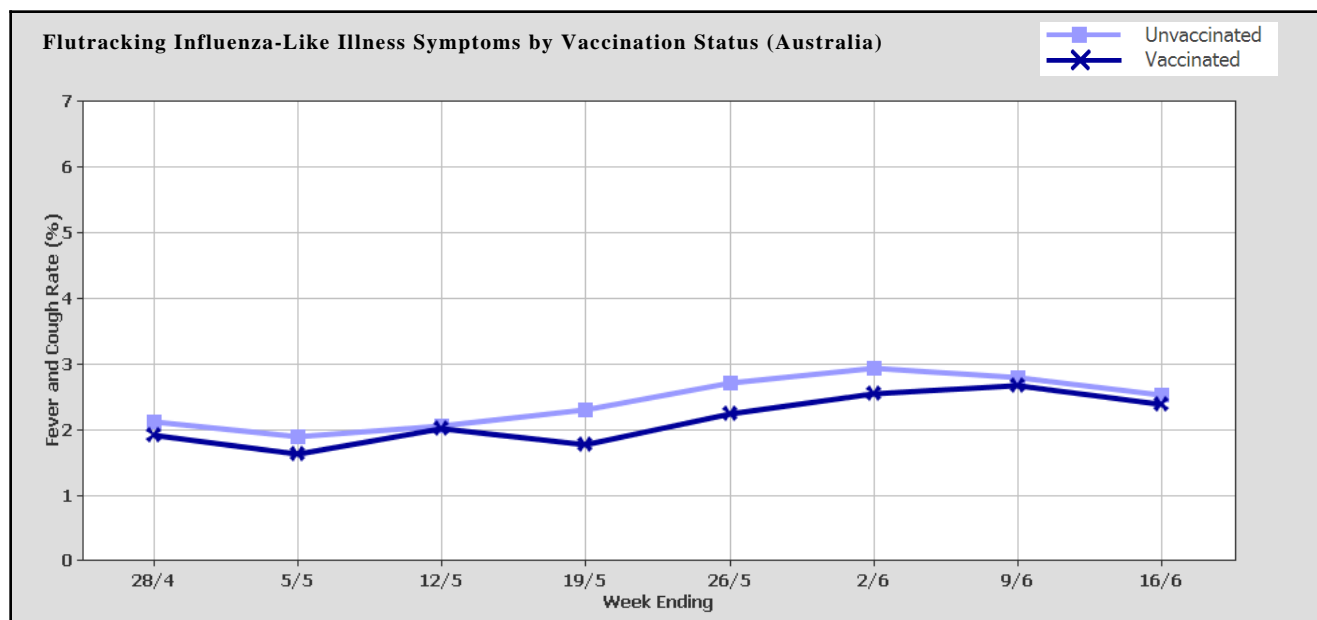
This survey was sent on Monday 17 June 12:31 AM and by Thursday 20 June 9:00 AM we had received 14574 responses (14619 last week) from 9398 people responding for themselves and 5176 household members across Australia.

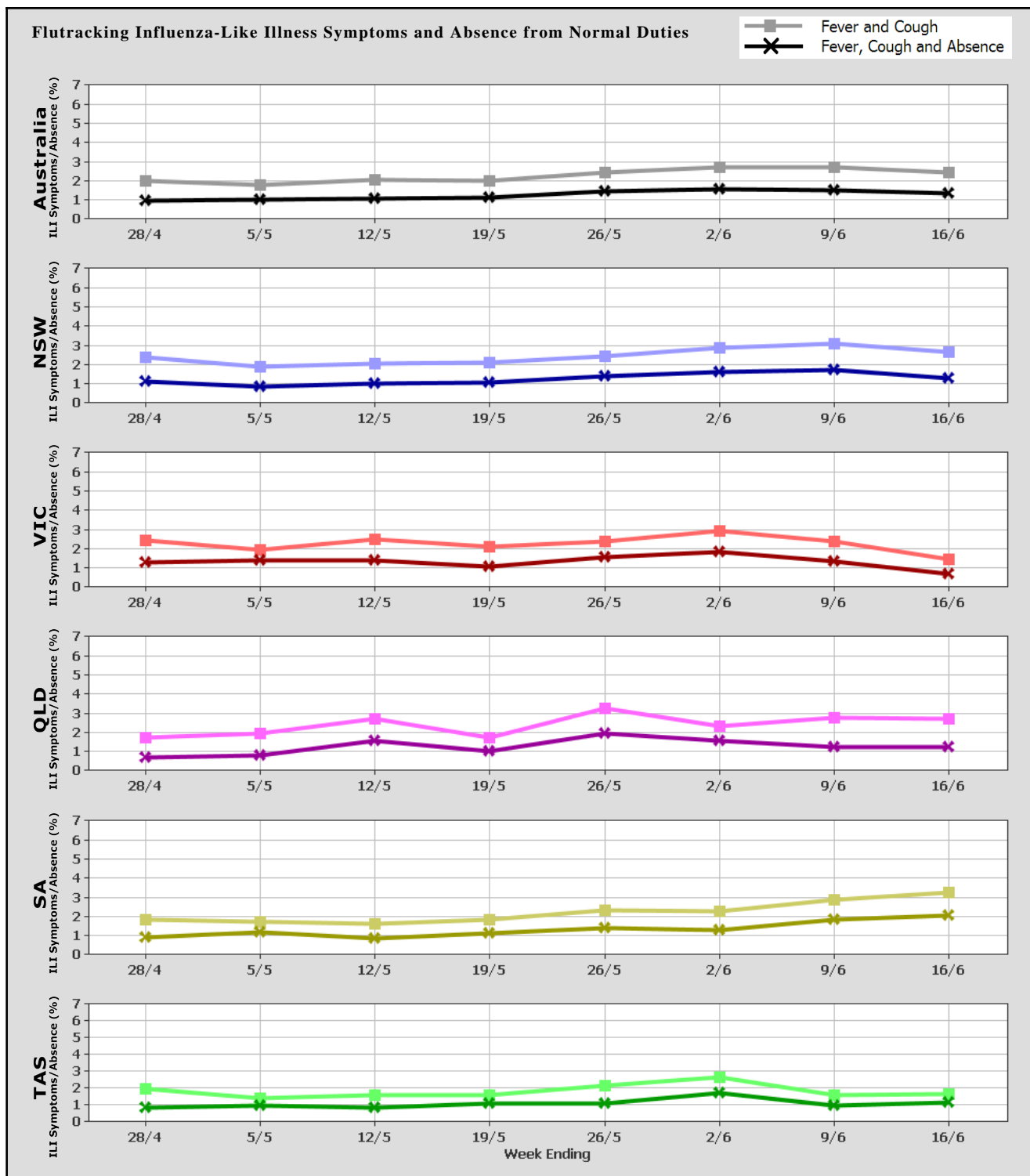

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.4% of vaccinated participants and 2.5% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.3% of vaccinated participants and 1.4% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8568/14574 (58.8%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2862 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2211 (77.3%) have received the vaccine.
