Low level influenza-like illness activity.


This survey was sent on Monday 24 June 12:49 AM and by Thursday 27 June 9:00 AM we had received 14544 responses (14559 last week) from 9354 people responding for themselves and 5190 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.6% of vaccinated participants and 2.7% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.5% of vaccinated participants and 1.4% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8520/14543 (58.6%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2861 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2206 (77.1%) have received the vaccine.
