Week #10 - ending 30 June 2013

Low level influenza-like illness activity.


This survey was sent on Monday 1 July 5:16 AM and by Thursday 4 July 9:00 AM we had received 14295 responses (14509 last week) from 9254 people responding for themselves and 5041 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.7% of vaccinated participants and 3.0% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.6% of vaccinated participants and 1.7% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8503/14295 (59.5%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2828 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2186 (77.3%) have received the vaccine.
