

# Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #11 - ending 7 July 2013

## Low level influenza-like illness activity.


This survey was sent on Monday 8 July 4:54 AM and by Thursday 11 July 9:00 AM we had received 14030 responses (14303 last week) from 9078 people responding for themselves and 4952 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.5% of vaccinated participants and 2.8% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.5% of vaccinated participants and 1.5% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8362/14027 (59.6%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2779 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2167 (78.0%) have received the vaccine.
