Week #12 - ending 14 July 2013

Low level influenza-like illness activity.


This survey was sent on Monday 15 July 12:43 AM and by Tuesday 16 July 9:00 AM we had received 12900 responses (13080 last week) from 8350 people responding for themselves and 4550 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.6% of vaccinated participants and 2.7% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.4% of vaccinated participants and 1.4% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 7683/12900 (59.6%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2517 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 1944 (77.2%) have received the vaccine.
