Low levels of influenza-like illness activity.


This survey was sent on Monday 29 July 12:19 AM and by Thursday 1 August 9:00 AM we had received 14782 responses (14672 last week) from 9540 people responding for themselves and 5242 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.4% of vaccinated participants and 2.7% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.5% of vaccinated participants and 1.6% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8793/14782 (59.5%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2963 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2313 (78.1%) have received the vaccine.
