Week #15 - ending 4 August 2013

Low levels of influenza-like illness activity.

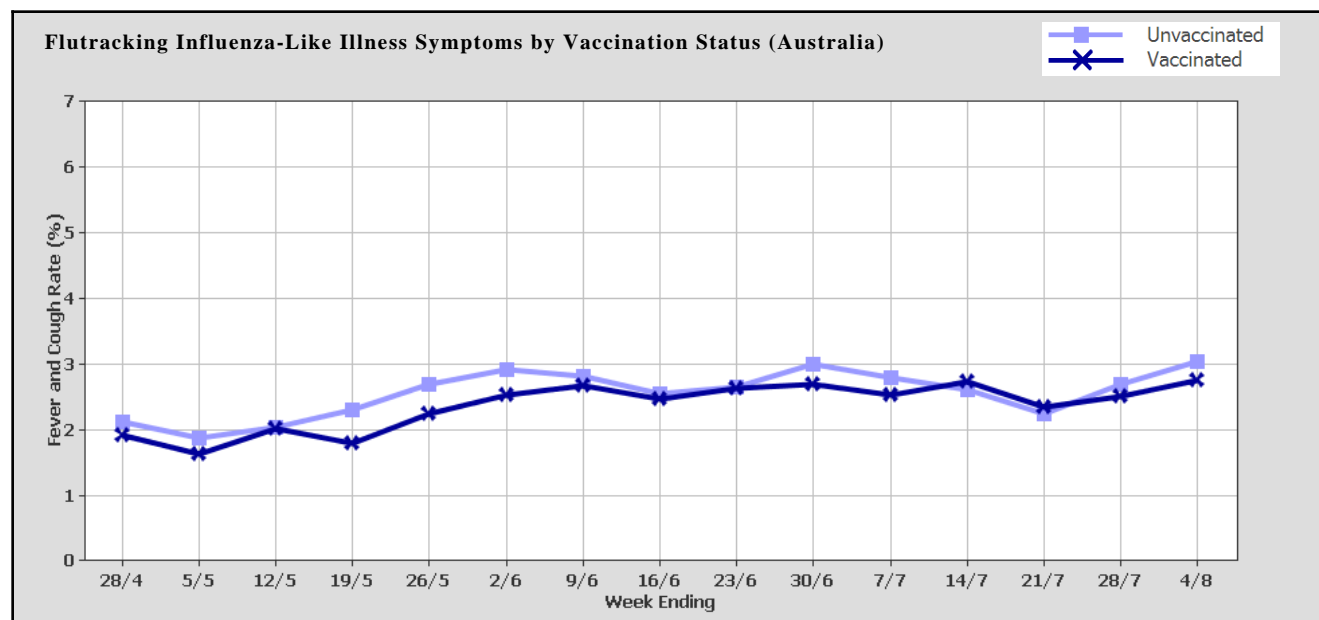
This survey was sent on Monday 5 August 12:17 AM and by Thursday 8 August 9:00 AM we had received 14716 responses (14786 last week) from 9542 people responding for themselves and 5174 household members across Australia.

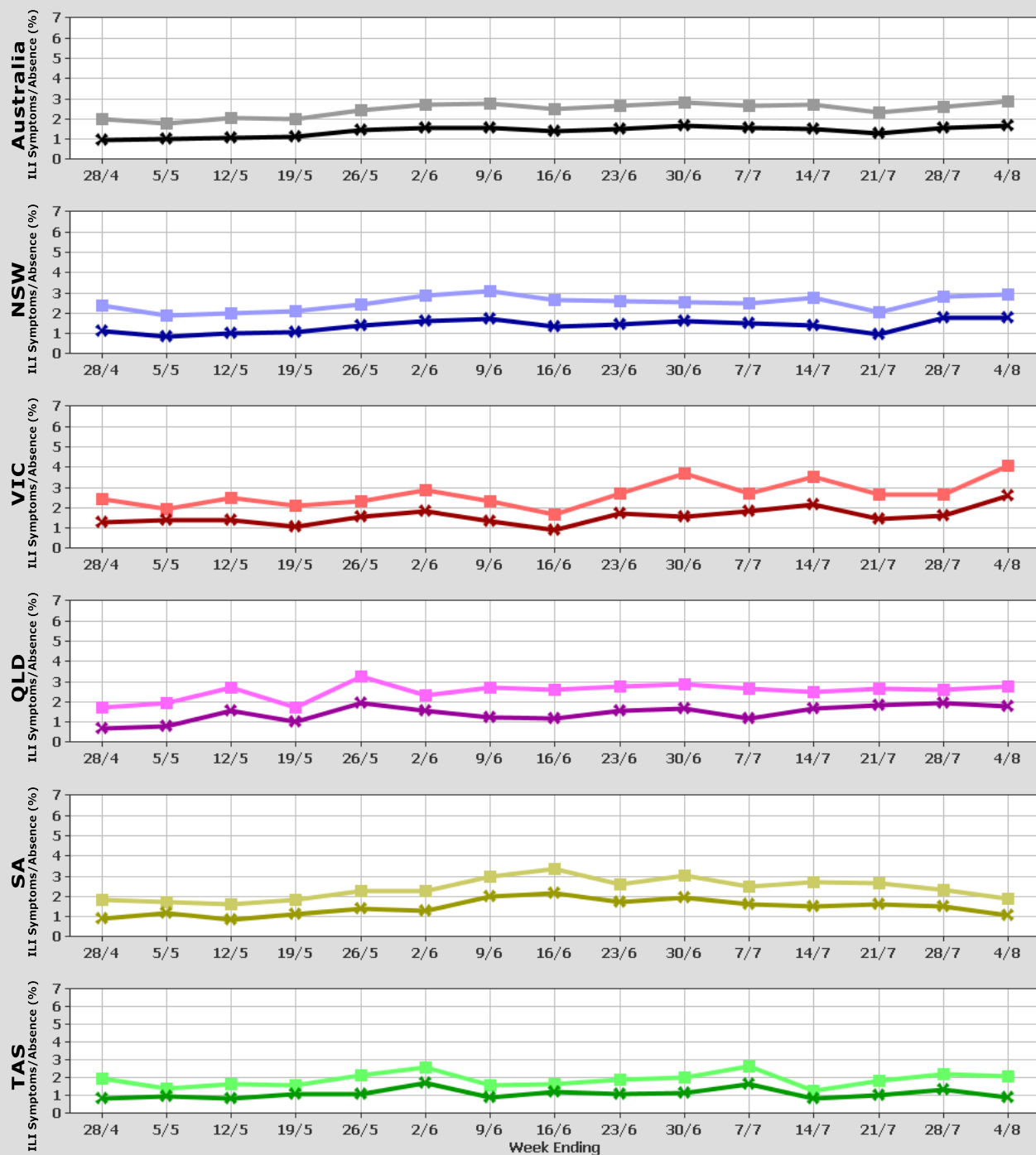
Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.8% of vaccinated participants and 3.0% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.7% of vaccinated participants and 1.6% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8843/14715 (60.1%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 3006 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2349 (78.1%) have received the vaccine.
