

## Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #16 - ending 11 August 2013

### Low levels of influenza-like illness activity.


This survey was sent on Monday 12 August 12:12 AM and by Thursday 15 August 9:00 AM we had received 14799 responses (14718 last week) from 9547 people responding for themselves and 5252 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.7% of vaccinated participants and 3.5% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.7% of vaccinated participants and 2.3% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8859/14797 (59.9%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 3072 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2394 (77.9%) have received the vaccine.
