

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #19 - ending 1 September 2013

Moderate levels of influenza-like illness activity.

This survey was sent on Monday 2 September 5:15 AM and by Thursday 5 September 9:00 AM we had received 14546 responses (14746 last week) from 9360 people responding for themselves and 5186 household members across Australia.

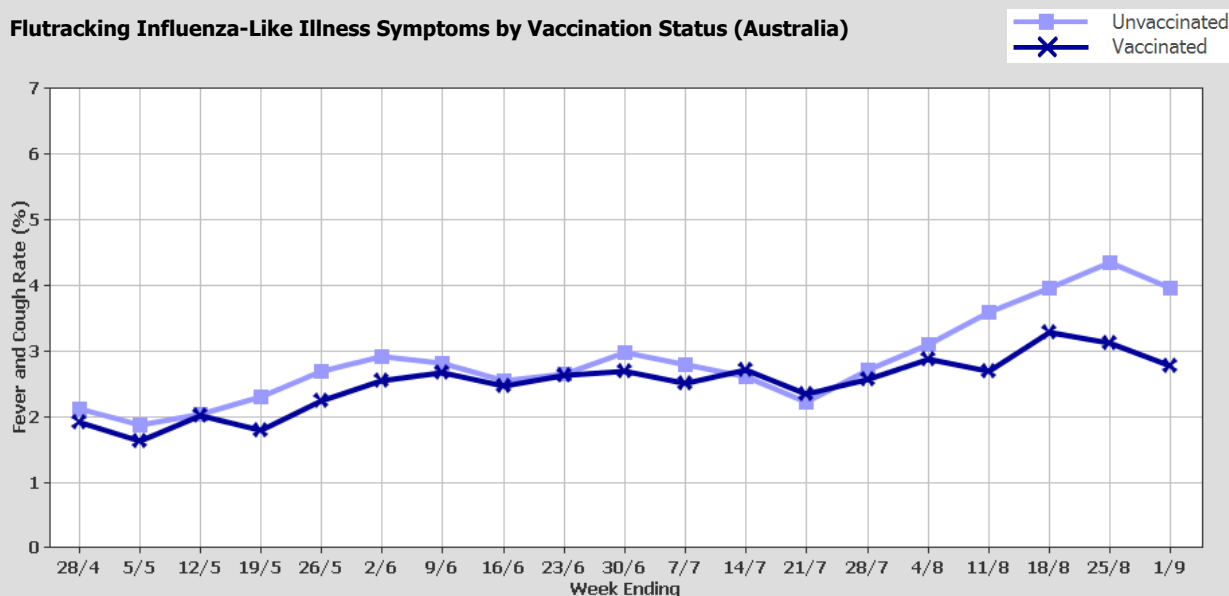

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.8% of vaccinated participants and 4.0% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.7% of vaccinated participants and 2.4% of unvaccinated participants.

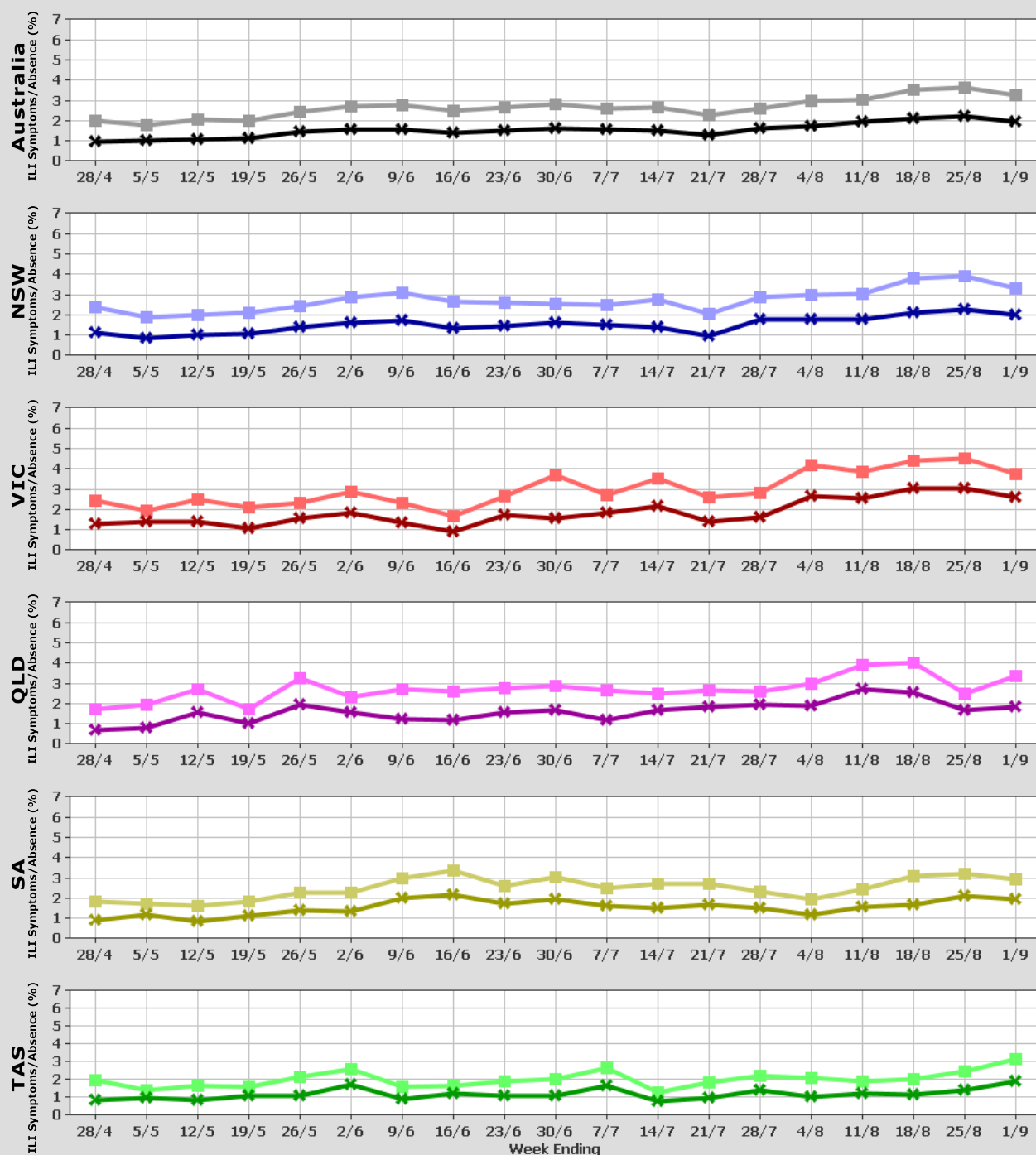
For participants this week, 8706/14545 (59.9%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2974 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2342 (78.7%) have received the vaccine.
