

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #20 - ending 8 September 2013

Low levels of influenza-like illness activity.

This survey was sent on Monday 9 September 7:42 AM and by Thursday 12 September 9:00 AM we had received 14473 responses (14511 last week) from 9342 people responding for themselves and 5131 household members across Australia.

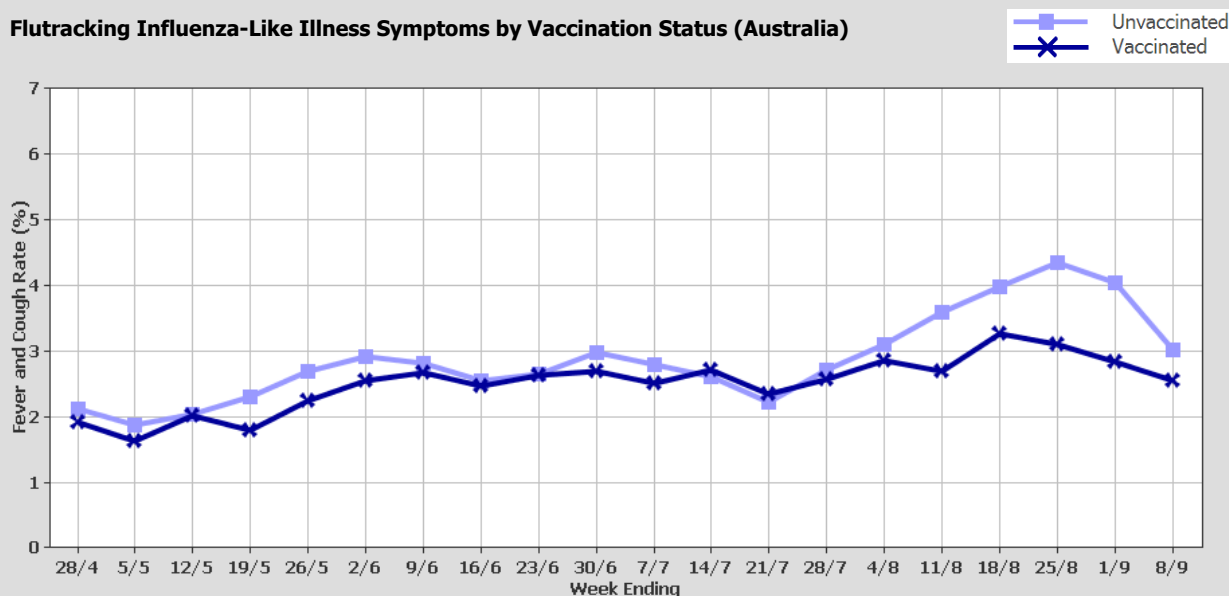

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.5% of vaccinated participants and 3.0% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.5% of vaccinated participants and 1.7% of unvaccinated participants.

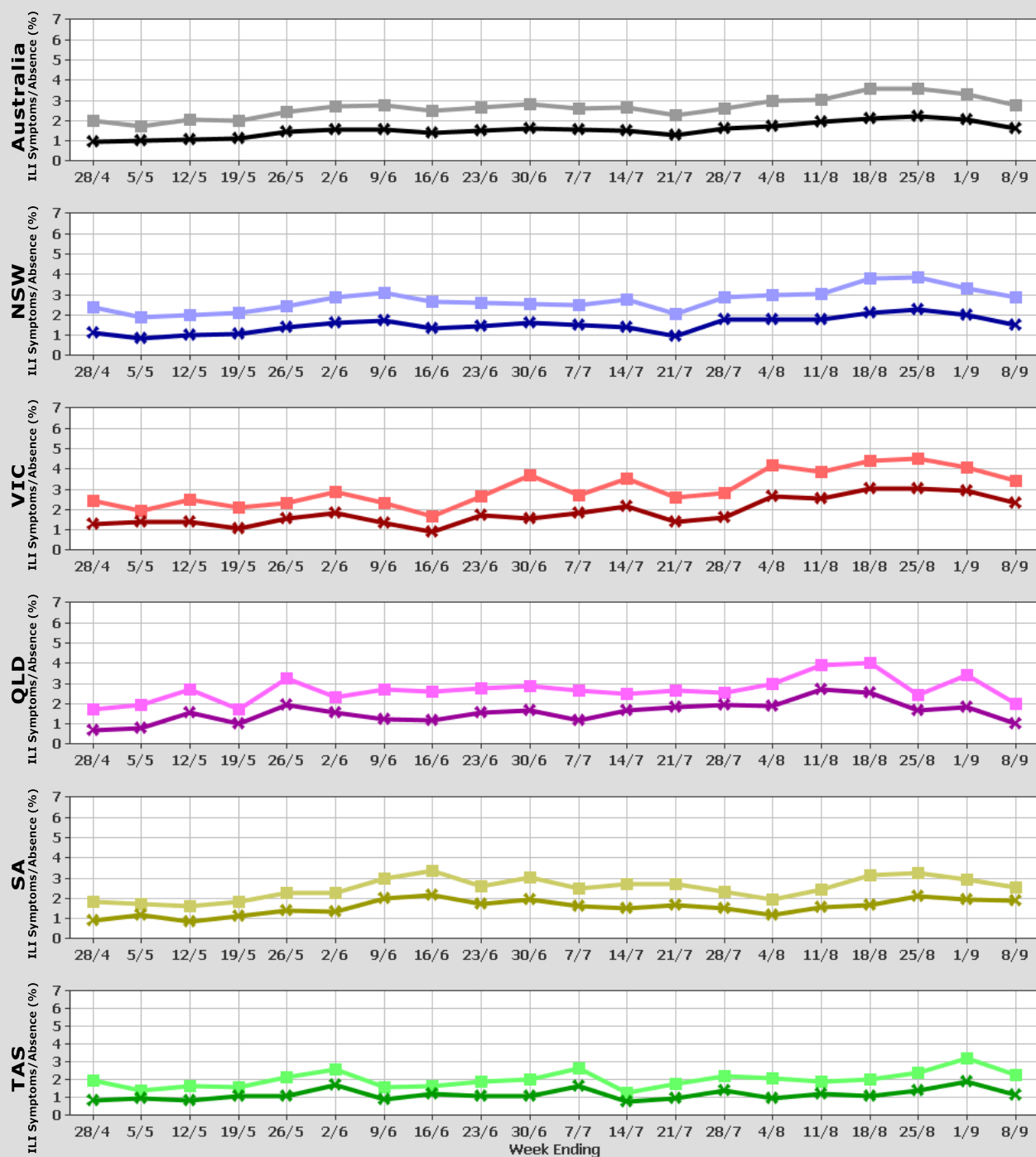
For participants this week, 8671/14465 (59.9%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2957 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2321 (78.5%) have received the vaccine.
