Low levels of influenza-like illness activity.


This survey was sent on Monday 16 September 6:15 AM and by Thursday 19 September 9:00 AM we had received 14623 responses (14499 last week) from 9432 people responding for themselves and 5191 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.6% of vaccinated participants and 2.7% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.6% of vaccinated participants and 1.7% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8756/14614 (59.9%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2982 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2344 (78.6%) have received the vaccine.
