

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #22 - ending 22 September 2013

Low levels of influenza-like illness activity.

This survey was sent on Monday 23 September 12:32 AM and by Thursday 26 September 9:00 AM we had received 13936 responses (14719 last week) from 9021 people responding for themselves and 4915 household members across Australia.

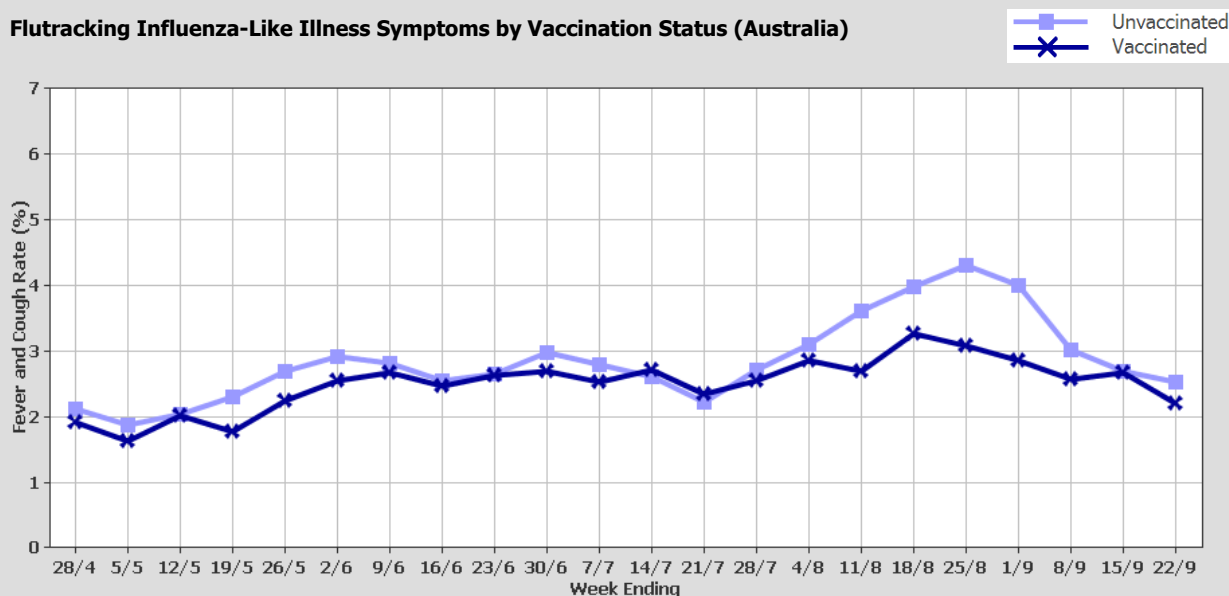

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.2% of vaccinated participants and 2.5% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.4% of vaccinated participants and 1.5% of unvaccinated participants.

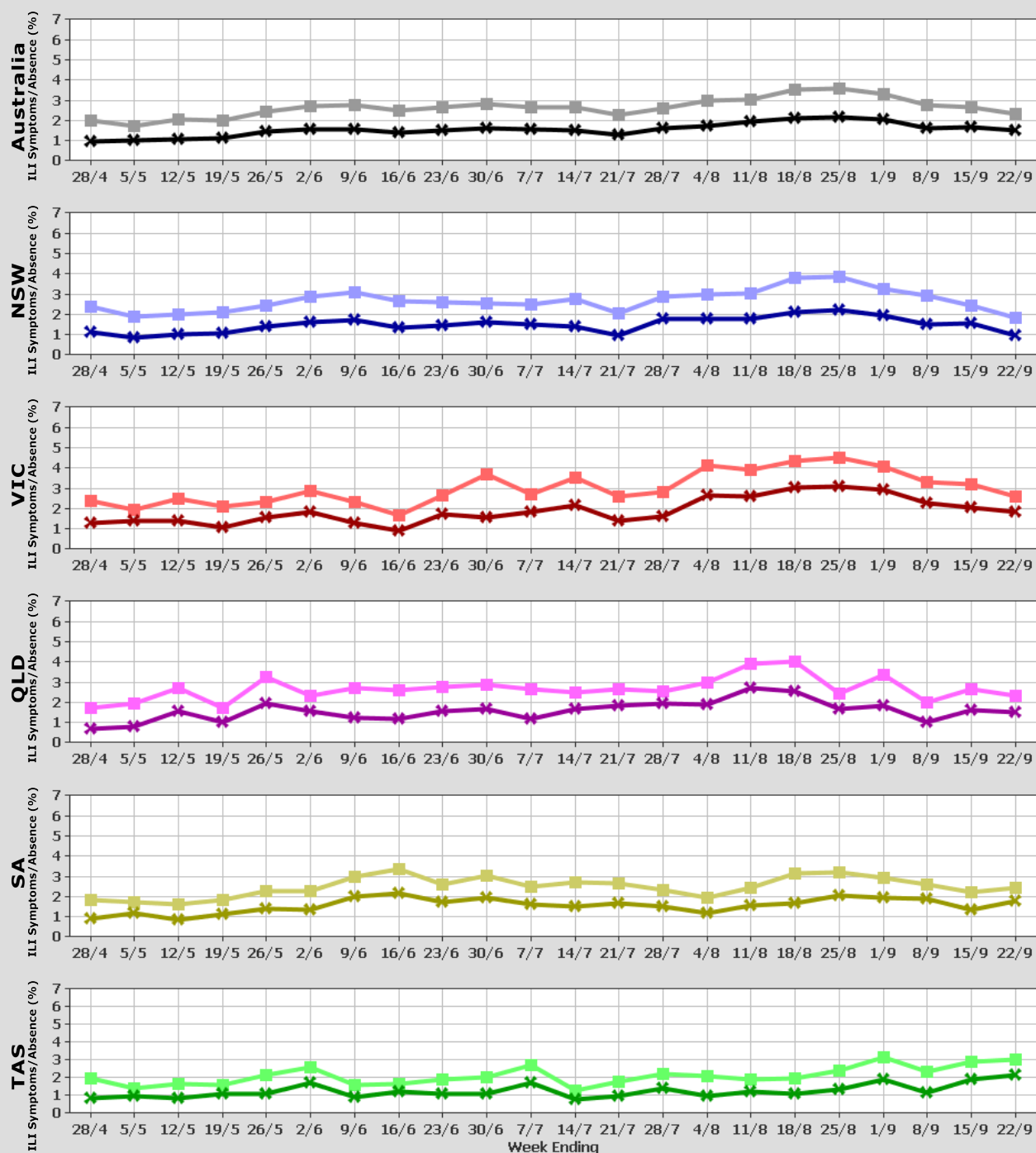
For participants this week, 8369/13926 (60.1%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2843 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2237 (78.7%) have received the vaccine.
