

Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week #40 - ending 29 September 2013

Low levels of influenza-like illness activity.

This survey was sent on Monday 30 September 12:21 AM and by Thursday 3 October 9:00 AM we had received 13392 responses (13941 last week) from 8740 people responding for themselves and 4652 household members across Australia.

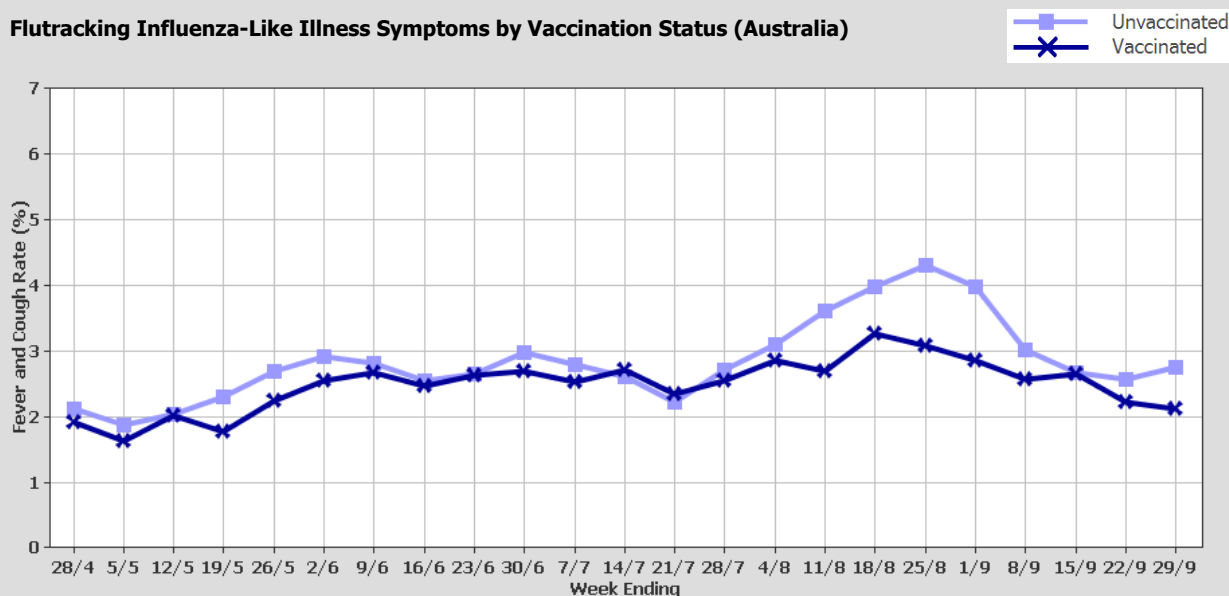

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.1% of vaccinated participants and 2.7% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.2% of vaccinated participants and 1.6% of unvaccinated participants.

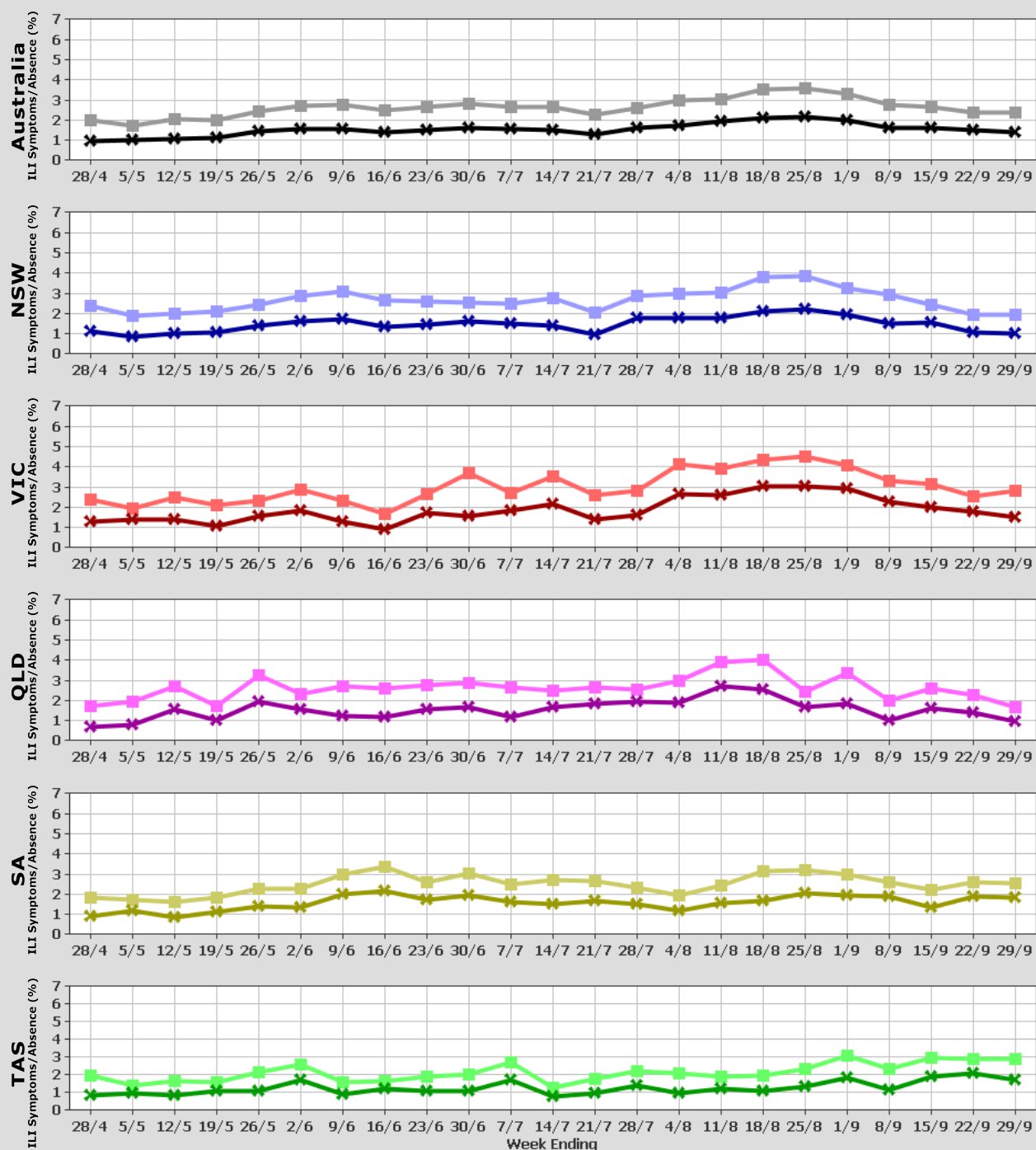
For participants this week, 8103/13389 (60.5%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2753 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2155 (78.3%) have received the vaccine.
