Low levels of influenza-like illness activity.


This survey was sent on Monday 7 October 12:19 AM and by Thursday 10 October 9:00 AM we had received 13911 responses (13392 last week) from 8977 people responding for themselves and 4934 household members across Australia.


Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 1.8% of vaccinated participants and 2.6% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.0% of vaccinated participants and 1.7% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8313/13909 (59.8%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2870 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2244 (78.2%) have received the vaccine.
