Low levels of influenza-like illness activity.


This survey was sent on Monday 14 October 12:46 AM and by Thursday 17 October 9:00 AM we had received 14197 responses (13884 last week) from 9207 people responding for themselves and 4990 household members across Australia.


Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 1.7% of vaccinated participants and 2.0% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.9% of vaccinated participants and 1.1% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8561/14195 (60.3%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2930 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2304 (78.6%) have received the vaccine.
