

## Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

### Week #43 - ending 20 October 2013

#### Low levels of influenza-like illness activity.


This survey was sent on Monday 21 October 7:32 AM and by Wednesday 23 October 9:00 AM we had received 13689 responses (13725 last week) from 8843 people responding for themselves and 4846 household members across Australia.


Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 1.6% of vaccinated participants and 1.7% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.0% of vaccinated participants and 0.9% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8180/13680 (59.8%) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 2772 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2170 (78.3%) have received the vaccine.
