## Low levels of influenza-like illness activity

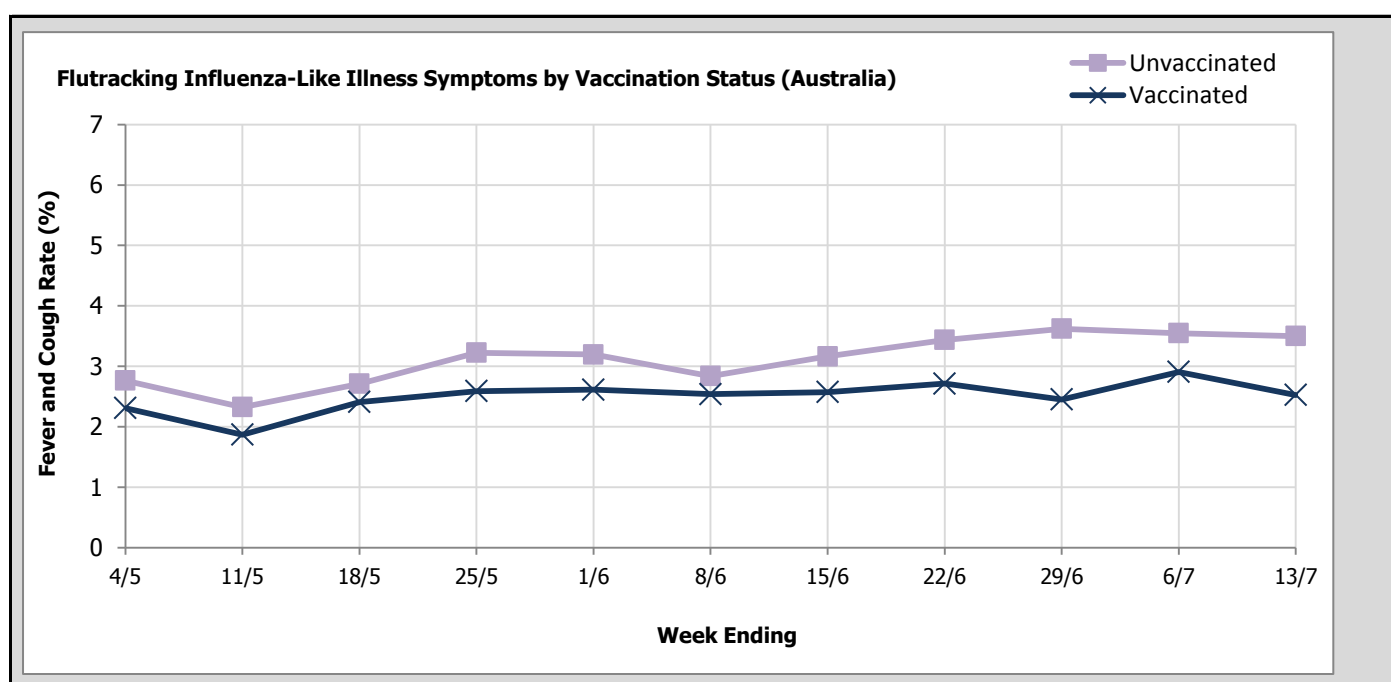
This survey was sent on Monday 14 July 6:04 and by Wednesday 16 July 9:00 we had received 15414 responses (15141 last week) from 9676 people responding for themselves and 5738 household members across Australia.

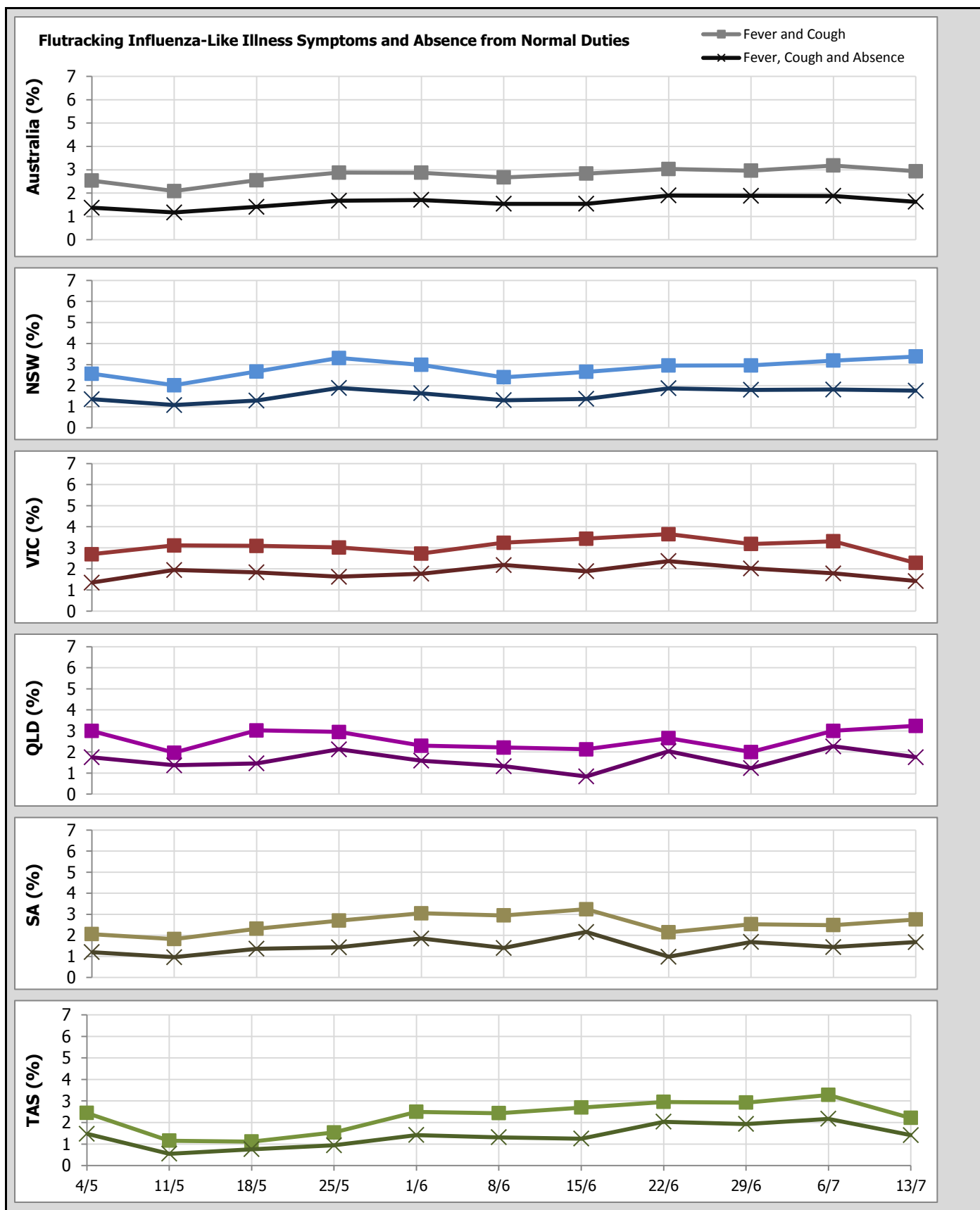

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.5 % of vaccinated participants and 3.5 % of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.4 % of vaccinated participants and 2.0 % of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 8986/15413 (58.3 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 3033 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2385 (78.6 %) have received the vaccine.
