

# Flutracking Weekly Interim Report

Week ending 18 October 2015

## Low levels of influenza-like illness activity

This survey was sent on Monday, 19 October 2015 at 01:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 22 October we had received 20382 responses (20198 last week) from 12500 people responding for themselves and 7882 household members across Australia.

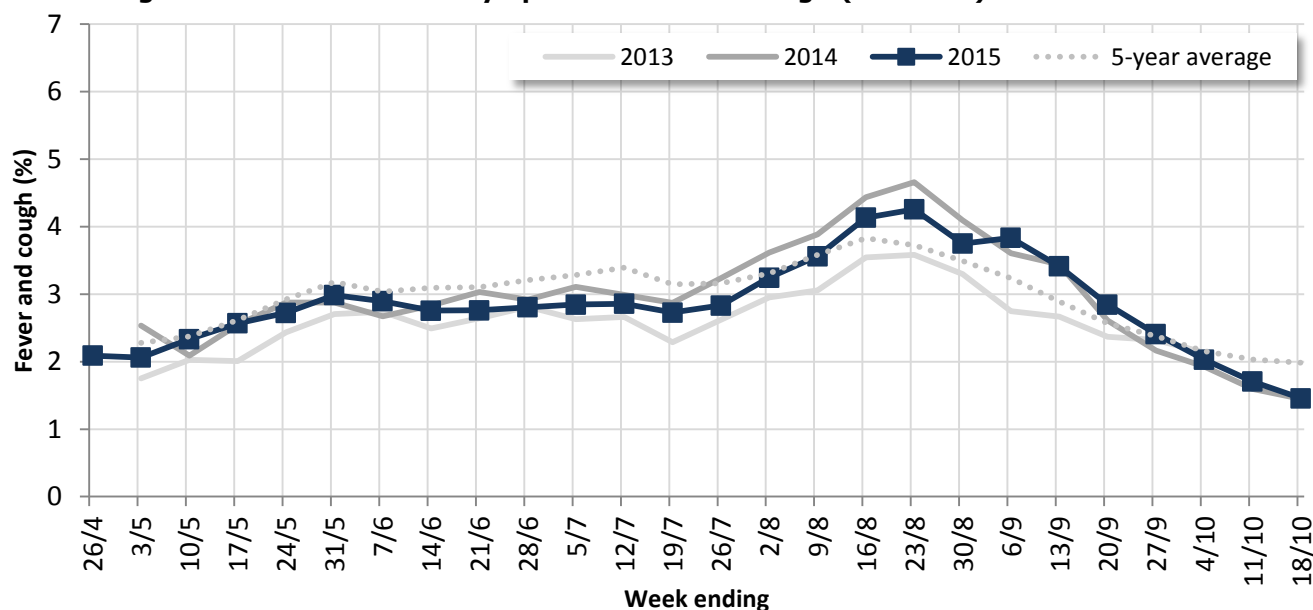
### Respondent Numbers by Jurisdiction

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 1.5% of vaccinated participants and 1.5% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.9% of vaccinated participants and 0.9% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 12756/20382 (62.6 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 4188 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 3413 (81.5%) have received the vaccine.

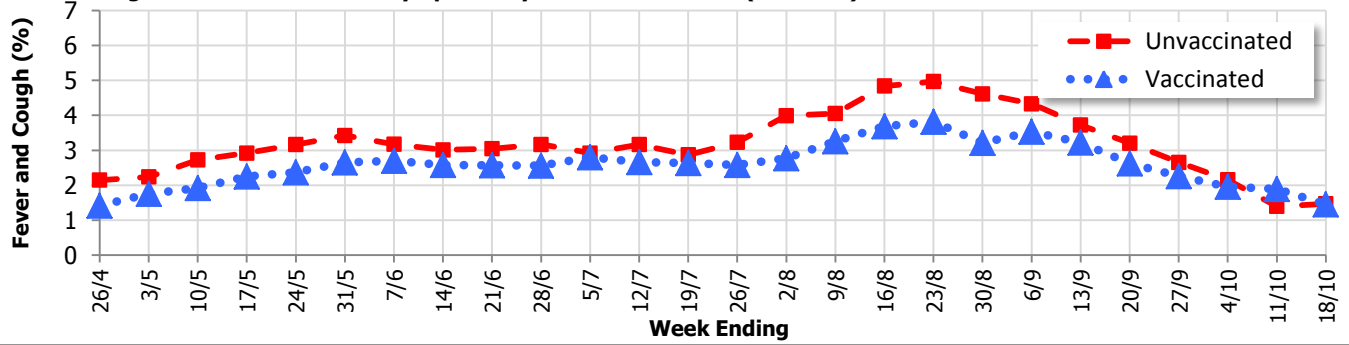
