Low levels of influenza-like illness activity


This survey was sent on Monday, 08 May 2017 at 01:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 11 May we had received 23459 responses (22449 last week) from 14053 people responding for themselves and 9406 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 1.3% of vaccinated participants and 1.4% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 0.8% of vaccinated participants and 0.8% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 10455/23459 (44.6 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 4398 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 2530 (57.5%) have received the vaccine.
