### Low levels of influenza-like illness activity


This survey was sent on Monday, 03 July 2017 at 01:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 06 July we had received 23603 responses (24704 last week) from 14375 people responding for themselves and 9228 household members across Australia.

#### Respondent Numbers by Jurisdiction



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 1.8% of vaccinated participants and 2.1% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.2% of vaccinated participants and 1.4% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 14540/23603 (61.6 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 4468 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 3571 (79.9%) have received the vaccine.
