Low levels of influenza-like illness activity

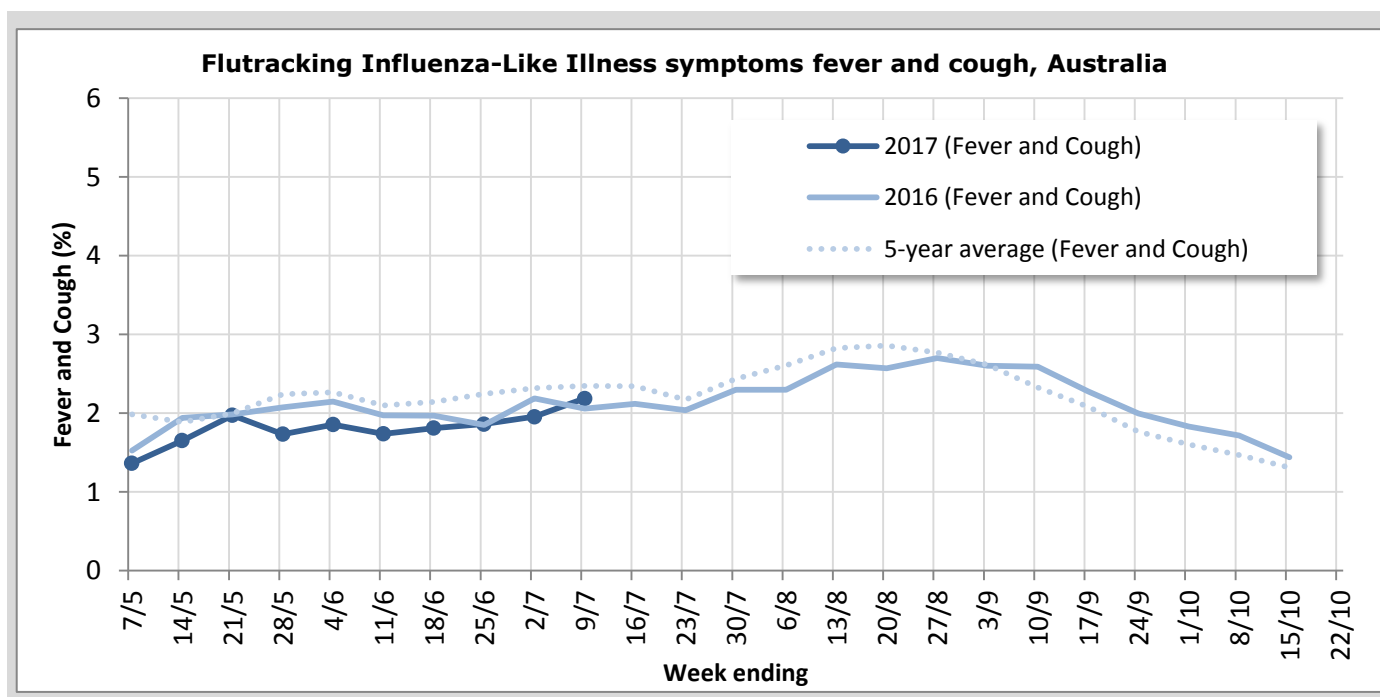
This survey was sent on Monday, 10 July 2017 at 01:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 13 July we had received 23675 responses (23779 last week) from 14455 people responding for themselves and 9220 household members across Australia.

Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.0% of vaccinated participants and 2.5% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 1.2% of vaccinated participants and 1.6% of unvaccinated participants.

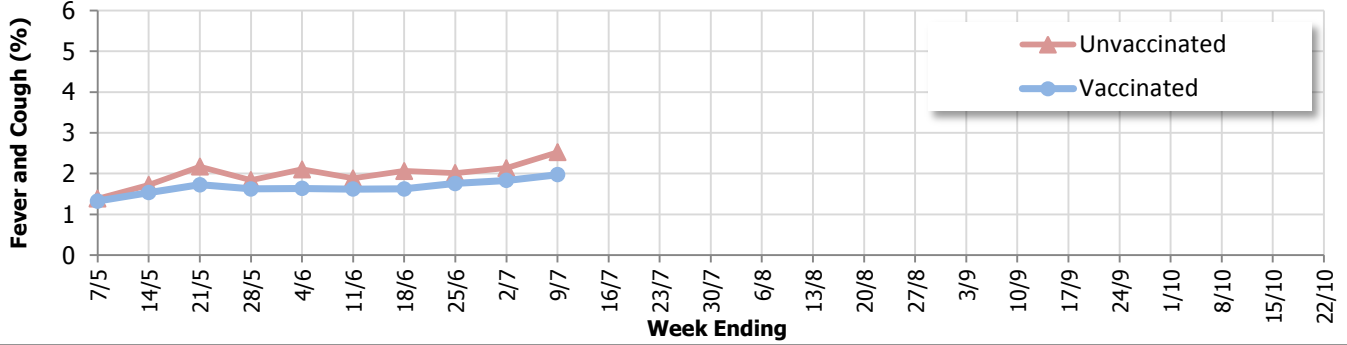
For participants this week, 14689/23675 (62.0 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 4417 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 3542 (80.2%) have received the vaccine.
