Moderate levels of influenza-like illness activity


This survey was sent on Monday, 07 August 2017 at 01:13 AM and by 09:00 AM, Thursday 10 August we had received 25225 responses (24857 last week) from 15109 people responding for themselves and 10116 household members across Australia.



Across Australia, fever and cough was reported by 2.6% of vaccinated participants and 4.0% of unvaccinated participants. Fever, cough and absence from normal duties was reported by 2.0% of vaccinated participants and 3.2% of unvaccinated participants.

For participants this week, 15637/25225 (62.0 %) have received the seasonal vaccine so far. Of the 4647 participants who identified as working face-to-face with patients, 3735 (80.4%) have received the vaccine.
